Dear Parishioners,
"Blessed are you who believe."

We are just a few days away from Christmas. The days can be stressful as there lie before us many things that must be done. Some of us wonder how it will all get done.

It will all get done!

The Gospel story is the beautiful retelling of the Visitation, Mary greets her cousin Elizabeth. This is the season of many "visitations" as we attend holiday gatherings, special holiday performances, and observe many traditions. As we visit and celebrate with our families, the people we work with, the people we worship with, we are invited to reflect on the relationships in our lives that give us support, love, and hope.

My father's home parish was on the South Side and is named Visitation. To this day it is a spiritual anchor in the neighborhood of 55th and Halsted. Some of my earliest memories of "visiting the Lord" took place in that church. When we were visiting my grandmother as little children, we always made time to "make a visit" to the Church.

Mary visited her cousin Elizabeth shortly after becoming pregnant. Elizabeth was pregnant with John the Baptist. It is always powerful for me to remember that the first person to recognize Jesus as the Lord was an unborn child.

In our many visits in the coming days, we can look to the story of the Visitation as an encounter with Christ, who lies within us. We like Mary, are bearers of Christ to the world. How much it could change our treatment of one another if we took seriously this reality that the Lord lies within us.

From those first witnesses to the birth of Jesus, to millions and millions of believers today, we cannot hear the story of the events that led to his birth enough. The upcoming celebrations of Christmas invite us to ponder the deeper reality of Christ alive in our midst.

Dear Parishioners -

The Christmas Season reminds us of God's Infinite Love and Mercy in our lives!

Thank you for your wonderful support of the Needy Family Fund during a difficult year of violence and unrest. Your support is amazing. Know that my prayers are with you.

People struggle every day. They live in fear and feel helpless. Rents have tripled in the past year. Jobs continue to be cut to part-time with no benefits. Homelessness continues to grow. More families are living in their car. Children suffer a great deal when they are homeless. The number of homeless children in our country right now is a staggering 1.8 million. It is a disgrace. How do they learn or feel good about themselves when they live in the car, woods, or in a shelter - sometimes separated from their family? They become isolated, angry, and live in fear.



Mothers continue to come from our community in need of food, warm clothing for their children, hygiene products, laundry detergent, and more, because they have so little. Respect Life Ministry

Please contact your state senator and representative now to express your opposition to Senate Bill 3499, a proposed piece of legislation that seeks to legalize assisted suicide in Illinois.

Proponents refer to this as Medical Aid in Dying (MAID), but using the word "medical" to describe the intentional taking of a life distorts the meaning of medicine and masks what SB 3499 is about, which is why we continue to refer to this as "assisted suicide."

Laws permitting assisted suicide pose significant risks to the poor, marginalized, and disabled, who may face pressure to end their lives rather than receive the care and compassion they need and deserve.

Illinois does not need to legalize assisted suicide. What we truly need is increased access to quality health care, enhanced palliative care options, and loving and compassionate support services for those at the end of their life. These are the alternatives that uphold the dignity of every person.

Finally, we ask for your prayers for the conversion of hearts among those who support assisted suicide.

And, being a parent doesn't always mean that you automatically or instinctively know what to do. Parent Effectiveness Training (P.E.T.) offers proven communication skills that really work. 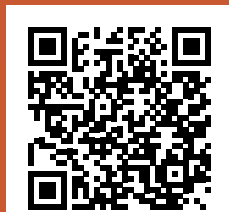
