Dear Parishioners,

"And over all these, put on love."

It is wonderful that during the Christmas Season we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family. In addition to reflecting on the Holy Family we have this wonderful passage from St. Paul's Letter to the Colossians proclaimed this weekend, which encourages us to reflect on our own families. I would encourage all of us to clip this passage and tape it to

the front door of the refrigerator. For many families this is the place where not to miss messages get posted.

This passage has such inspiring words about the way we live with others, whether we live alone or have a house full of people.

We need to "bear with one another, we need live with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience.

We can easily take for granted those who we cherish the most. It does not take much for resentments and estrangements to emerge. How often people are wounded by misunderstandings or poor choices that have significant impact on how we are treated. Not everything can be easily healed but if we embrace the wisdom of this reading the quality of our life will be so much better when we walk with one another both in times of grace and times of struggle.

I served for many years at the Church of the Holy Family on Roosevelt Road in Chicago. One of the wonderful features of this historic church is its stunning Main Altar. At the center is a copy of Murillo's masterpiece, "The Holy Family." The painting is surrounded by statues of Jesus's Aunt and Uncle, St. Zechariah and St. Elizabeth and his Grandparents, the parents of Mary, St. Joachim, and St. Ann. It is the family album of Jesus. We know so little about Jesus' childhood other than the reference in the Gospel today, relatives surrounded Jesus just like you and me. They loved him as do we!

I wanted to give a special shoutout to **Moira Haithcock** who is the heart and soul of our Religious Education Program. For years she has been one of those people that makes things happen. She is utterly devoted to our Religious Education Community and OLPH. Thank you, Moira, I do not know what we would do without you!


Mother of the Americas in Need of Paint






