Dear Parishioners,

"The glory of the Lord will shine upon you"

Happy New Year!

A new year always ushers in a fair degree of anticipation. Some things we can anticipate will happen, children will be born, students will graduate, couples will get married, the Cubs will win the World Series! Other things will happen that we

didn't anticipate, a job loss, a promotion, a new friendship, a health crisis, the grace of reconciliation, the Sox setting a new record for the most losses in a season.

What ever happens, we know the Lord will be at our side as we face both the challenges and blessings that we will be facing in 2025. The first weekend of the New Year we observe the ancient Feast of the Epiphany. This feast has been observed longer than Christmas. In many cultures this feast is as widely celebrated as Christmas, with far more meaning than just the 12th day of Christmas.

At this time of year in which darkness captures most of the day in this hemisphere, we rejoice in the light, the light of Christ. The Star of Bethlehem guided the Three Kings to the Lord. The Light of Christ will guide us and lead us.

One of the great traditions of this feast was the Epiphany Proclamation. Long before people had calendars the Proclamation announced the dates of the upcoming solemn celebrations of the Church. Because the date of Easter is a movable feast based on an ancient calculation connected to the Jewish observance of Passover, the date many feasts are not set like Christmas on December 25. I thought you might like to read the Epiphany Proclamation of 2025:

Know, dear brethren, (brothers and sisters,) that, as we have rejoiced at the Nativity of our Lord Jesus Christ, so by leave of God's mercy we announce to you also the joy of his Resurrection, who is our Savior.

On the **fifth** day of **March** will fall Ash Wednesday, and the beginning of the fast of the most sacred Lenten season.

On the **twentieth** day of **April** you will celebrate with joy Easter Day, the Paschal feast of our Lord Jesus Christ.

[In those places where the Ascension is observed on Thursday:
On the **twenty-ninth** day of **May** will be the Ascension of our Lord Jesus Christ.]

(In those places where the Ascension is transferred to the Seventh Sunday of Easter:
On the **first** day of **June** will be the Ascension of our Lord Jesus Christ.)

On the eighth day of June, the feast of Pentecost.

On the **twenty-second** day of **June**, the feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ.

On the **thirtieth** day of **November**, the First Sunday of the Advent of our Lord Jesus Christ, to whom is honor and glory for ever and ever. Amen.

As the year unfolds, we will have many exciting things happening at the parish. We will be launching the Alpha Program which is an effort to gather people on spiritual issues and provide a social aspect to connect people more closely to the parish and their faith. We will be launching the capital campaign, "Generation to Generation" which will both benefit OLPH and the larger mission of the Archdiocese of Chicago. At some point, the McDonnell Hall renovation will be complete. We will celebrate baptisms, First Communions, Confirmations and weddings. We will have a men's morning of renewal on March 29. The next scripture study to soon begin is on "Women in the Old Testament".

There will be unexpected challenges that surround illness and death. There will be setbacks and difficulties but "the glory of the Lord will shine upon us."

This week we begin to return to the regular rhythms of life. May this be a year of grace as we begin the Jubilee Year, "Pilgrims of Hope."

I was delighted last week to confirm **Thomas Preston**. He is the son of **Geoff and Jennifer Preston**. Thomas was a 2024 graduate of OLPH school but because of a calendar conflict he wasn't able to be confirmed last Spring. As the Interim Vicar, I delegated myself to preside at his Confirmation. I was so honored and grateful that I could celebrate this sacrament for him. He took the name Sebastian. He took this name because St. Sebastian is the patron saint of athletes and he is a talented hockey player. Congratulations "Sebastian" Preston.

Throughout this New Year, may we have many occasions to witness "the Glory of the Lord."




