Dear Parishioners,

"The favor of God was upon him."

Today is the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord in the Temple. Before the liturgical reforms of Vatican 2, the Christmas Season did not formally end until this feast. It is still a custom in Italy to keep Nativity Scenes up until today.

The Evangelist Luke paints a wonderful picture of this moment when the child Jesus is presented in the temple to complete the Jewish rituals that surrounded the birth of a child. There is much drama as Mary and Joseph experience the mysterious reception of Jesus in the temple by Simeon who performed the rituals and Anna the prophetess. It is clear in their words that Jesus would be the source of tremendous anticipation and wonderment.

In a custom that goes back to the earliest of times, this feast is also the occasion to bless candles that will be used in the Church throughout the new year. Jesus is the light of the world! These candles will help sanctify our altars at liturgy, candles are given to the parents of the newly baptized.

Ever so gradually, daylight is extending, slowly, the period of darkness begins to recede. As Christians we believe that Jesus is the light of the world. He brings light and hope because "the favor of God was upon him."

Through our baptisms, the favor of the Lord is upon us! This sense of being blessed by God can be a great power in life as we contemplate what the Lord is asking of us, the directions and choices he hopes we will pursue, I have been thinking about our 8th graders in the school and Religious Ed who are making their final preparations for Confirmation. I hope they will come to appreciate that the favor of God is upon them as they will be anointed with the oil of chrism and are sealed by the Holy Spirit.

I also feel this way about the couples who are preparing for marriage. The Lord will find favor upon them as they prepare to be united at the table of the Lord.

The favor of God is upon us and will hopefully shape and influence us.

I am honored to preside at the Scout Mass this coming Sunday. We have a great tradition of the Scouting program here at OLPH. I am grateful to many of our adults who lead and support our young people. I was so proud last weekend that several of our scouts were honored at Holy Name Cathedral for completing the requirements for the Parvuli Dei and the Ad Altare Dei Religious Awards. As an Eagle Scout myself I know how influential the Scouting

program can be. At our Mass, several scouts and their leaders will be recognized for their contributions.

Last Saturday's Poker Night by the Men's Club was a great success, special thanks to our teens who assembled several casseroles for the food pantries we serve, and the Diaper Drive looks to be very successful.

All week we have been celebrating Catholic Schools week. Thanks to all of you for your generous support of our school.

This past week we had our monthly meeting with the Finance Council. Under the leadership of **Bridget Baumstark**, our Council provides me with invaluable advice on how to manage the financial challenges of our parish. As we have passed the midpoint of the fiscal year, I am so grateful for the extraordinary support and sacrifices you make to keep our parish moving forward. "The favor of God is upon us." Soon it will be budget time, ugh!

We recently lost two giants in our parish, **Bill Thome** and **Bob Anthony**.

Bill Thome was the father of **Kim Hand, Bill, and Donna**. He was very influential in our Sharing Ministry and as an usher.

# Hearing Assistance available in OLPH Church

### and McDonnell Hall



**OLPH** has a hearing loop installed. Users with a t-coil in their hearing aids can listen to the sound system directly. Check with your hearing care professional to determine whether your hearing aid or cochlear implant has a t-coil.

Please note that while the hearing loop can be accessed in both the main church and McDonnell Hall, both spaces cannot access the hearing loop at the same time. For example, at the 9:30am Sunday Mass when services are held concurrently in the main church and McDonnell Hall, the hearing loop can only be accessed in the main church.

For best results in the church, please sit in the front half of the church. The hearing loop may not be effective in the back of the church, in the side pews, or in the Lady Chapel.

For those with a hearing device that does not have a t-coil, or if you simply would like to hear the service better, **FM** based Assistive Listening Devices (ALD's) are available to borrow. Please plan to arrive for Mass a few minutes early to find Sr. Paulanne or an usher to access an ALD.

Note: An FM based ALD uses radio waves to conduct sound that is broadcast through the microphone.

#### Instructions for an FM based ALD

- 1. Remove any hearing aid that you may be wearing
- 2. Turn on the ALD device
- 3. Place the ALD ear piece in your ear
- 4. Adjust volume as necessary

#### Return all borrowed equipment to Sr. Paulanne after Mass.


