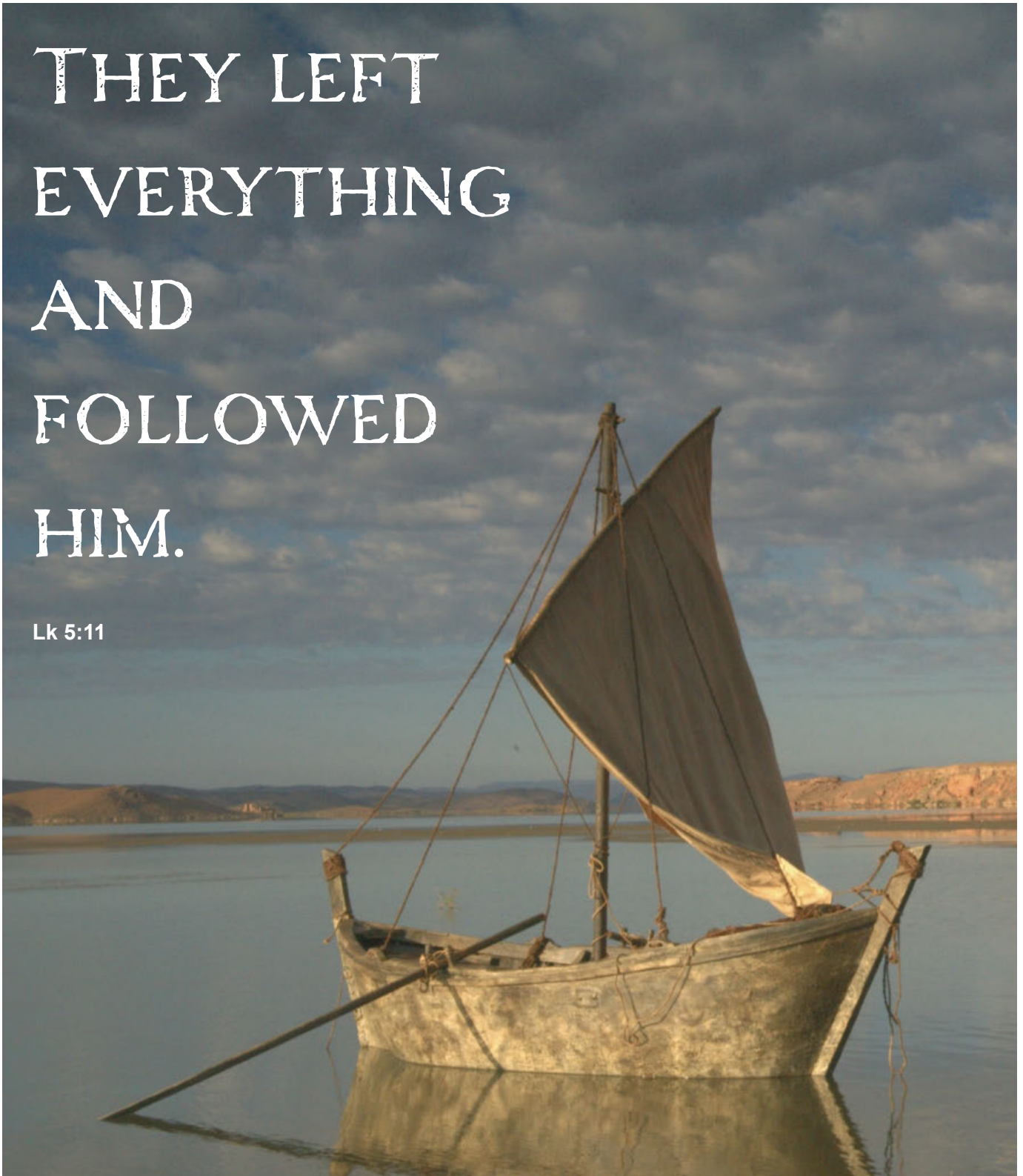

seek, share, rejoice - pastor's letter...

Dear Parishioners,

"They left everything and followed him."

At the core of our vocation to be a follower of Christ is this invitation to leave everything behind and follow the Lord. Some of the biggest things we need to leave behind do not lend easily to a cost appraisal. A bottom line of worth in terms of money.

Hard to put a cost analysis on what it means to leave our ego behind, our self-righteousness, our resentments. Materialism and selfishness also need to be left behind. The need to be in control, the energy we put into getting our way. These are all forces that keep us from developing a more authentic life as a follower of the One who invites us to journey with him.

In religious life we often reflect on the word "detachment." We need to let go of some things to embrace others. We need to let go of resentments to heal, we need to let go of fear to trust, we need to release our grief to hope again. We need to embrace love and move beyond hate.

In the Gospel, this weekend we are presented with the call of the apostles, Jesus' first and most trusted followers. On some level they had no idea what they were getting into. Such is the reality of the journey of faith, we never know where it leads to except ultimately to union with the Lord in eternity.

From time to time it's important to look back to appreciate how far we have come. One of the graces of getting older is the realization that some things that seemed so important just were not and other things taken for granted become precious.

You do not realize how critical your physical health is until you are sick. You do not realize how important certain relationships are until they get wounded by misunderstanding or we experience loss through death or some form of separation.

We are all in this together, we are all at various points of coming to terms with what I need to leave behind to follow him.

This Saturday we celebrate our Ministry Appreciation Liturgy. A day in the life of OLPH would be a remarkable journey of discovery. The realization of so many committed people to bring the mission of our parish to life as the Lord is celebrated in the Eucharist, children are formed, the hungry are fed, the scripture studied, grieving comforted, the lonely visited, the anxious encouraged, the homeless find shelter.

I never ceased to be amazed at the generosity and faith filled commitment of many to our life together as believers. I see every day many leaving behind their own needs to be

of service to others. This weekend I proclaim a communal THANK YOU! We are the parish we are because of your commitment, your sacrifice most of all your faith. With over sixty ministries and a multitude of people serving in so many capacities we are blessed beyond words.

I am grateful to the Parish Pastoral Council that worked so hard to plan this weekend's celebration.

This week several parishioners participated in the launch event at Our Lady of Wayside in Arlington Heights with **Cardinal Cupich**, the First Wave of the Diocesan Capital Campaign, "Generation to Generation, Answer the Call." You will be soon hearing more about this effort to assist pressing needs of the Church in the Archdiocese and several projects key to the future of our parish.

As the Vicar I recently had the pleasure of presiding at the celebration of the granting of the Golden Rose Award to High School women who have distinguished themselves by faithful leadership and service to the parishes and high schools of Vicariate 1. The event is planned by the Archdiocesan Council of Catholic Women. I was thrilled to present one of our own with a Golden Rose, **Emily Mathias**, a senior at Glenbrook South. She is a blessing to us and is one of the great leaders of our Youth Ministry Program here at OL. Congratulations to Emily who is hoping to pursue a career in Health Sciences in college. Our youth ministry program is flourishing with the likes of her!

I really enjoyed last week's observance of Scout Sunday. The liturgy was great, and the Pancake Breakfast afterwards was terrific. Special thanks to our Scoutmaster, **Doug Kissner** and the adults who help us have such an outstanding scout program. History has been made at OLPH! We acknowledged the conferral of the rank of Eagle Scout on the 87th member of Troop 57 to accomplish that honor. Congratulations to **Michaela Kissner** who is the first woman in the history of our parish to achieve this coveted award. Wow!!

Next weekend will be our annual celebration of Valentine's Day with the renewal of marriage vows at the 5:00pm Mass. (psst, then you are supposed to take her out to dinner).

Next weekend is announcement weekend for the Annual Catholic Appeal, "Together we bring Hope." The annual appeal is essential in supporting the many ministries of the Archdiocese. There is more information in the Bulletin. Last year we exceeded our goal by almost \$80,000! We get to keep most of that money and will be investing it in upgrades to the kitchen in McDonnell Hall.

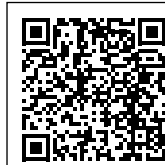

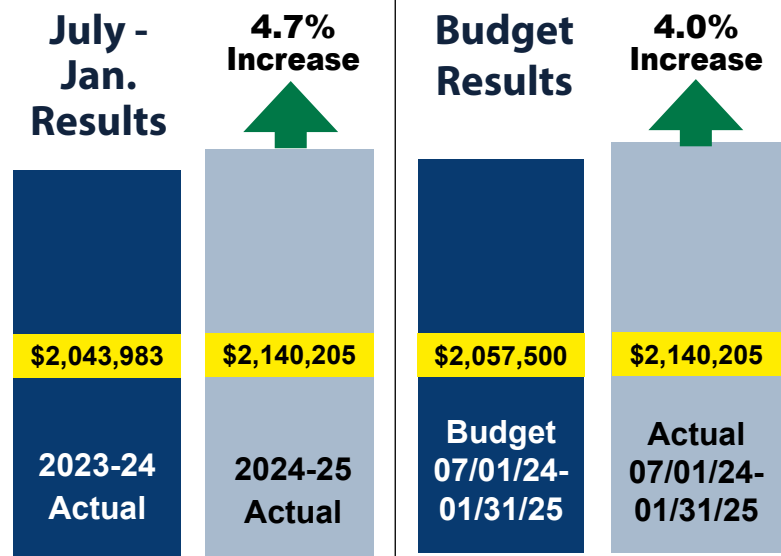
Stewardship Report

To all Parishioners:

Seven months of our fiscal year are now behind us. The results of Collections for the seven months are listed below. As a Parish Community, you have contributed \$2,140,205 towards Sunday and Holyday collections from July 1, 2024 to January 31, 2025.

This includes \$314,207 in donations towards our Christmas collection, which is 10% over last year and 8% over this year's budget. 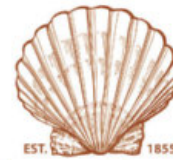

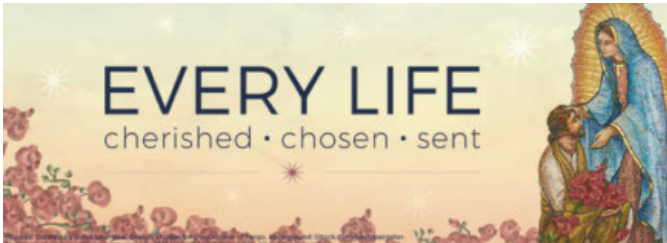

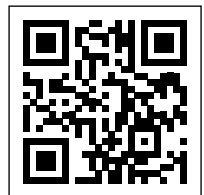
