Dear Parishioners,

"Blessed is the one who trusts in the Lord."

There are several references in the scriptures this weekend to the power of what it means to be blessed. To be blessed is to possess an inner peace, an inner happiness, an inward joy that is grounded in my relationship with the Lord.

I am often struck by people who approach the challenges of life from the perspective of being blessed. You can just tell it by their demeanor, their perspective, their attitude. These are folks who see the glass half full not half empty. They see life as a gift, each day full of opportunity, a sense of gratitude for what I have and not dwelling on what I do not have or wished I had.

In my ministry I encounter many people who are facing a major challenge, a terminal illness, the unexpected loss of a job, the prospect of a failed marriage. People who have this inner sense of being blessed navigate these turbulent waters with resolve and confidence that the Lord is with them.

We read in the gospel a litany of graces that come with being blessed, if we are hungry, we will be fed, if we are weeping, we will soon know joy, when we are poor, we will embrace the Kingdom of God.

Cultivating a sense of being blest is a lifelong task because we are constantly encountering obstacles that challenge our sense of being blest. Over the long haul of our earthly journey the Lord is constantly seeking to reassure us, to offer the prospect of healing, a new beginning, a second chance.

The spiritual challenge for the week might be to take some time to name the sources in your life that reveal that you are blest. What have been the moments or events in your life where you have felt the power of God's blessing in your life? Falling in love, having a child, a major accomplishment, preserving a period of trial, whatever those moments were, name the blessings that have shaped and formed you.

People who are blessed know they are blessed! You need to identify the sources of your blessings and thank God for his love for you.

This Saturday at the 5:00pm Mass, we celebrate the renewal of marriage vows as we mark Valentine's Day. Congratulations to all who are united in marriage. Please pray for all our engaged couples who will be getting married in the coming months.

Next weekend will be Commitment weekend for the annual Catholic Appeal. This year's theme is, "Together We Bring Hope." It echoes the theme of the Holy Year, "Pilgrims of Hope." It also resonates with the ongoing process of renewal and transformation in the Archdiocese of Chicago.

There are envelopes and brochures available at the exits for you to take on your way out. Across the next week, I invite you to reflect, pray, and ask yourself how you can bring hope. Hopefully, you can make a commitment to the annual Catholic Appeal next weekend. You may have already received an invitation to participate in the Appeal in the mail and you may have already contributed or made a decision, you are all set!

If we exceed our goal (\$213,548), additional funds are rebated to the parish. We will be using any additional funds to upgrade the kitchen in McDonnell Hall.

seek, share, rejoice - fr. patrick's uganda adventure...

On December 29, 2024, a group of parishioners and friends, led by **Fr. Patrick Kizza**, embarked on a journey of a lifetime to Uganda, Africa. One day later, the excited travelers, which included a determined 91-year-old OLPH parishioner, arrived in Entebbe, Uganda.

On New Year's Eve, the group joined hundreds of young Catholics at the Nsambya Youth Ministry Center in Kampala to ring in the New Year. In addition to meeting many seminarians and priests, they met and even chatted with Archbishop Augustine Kasujja who was the first African nuncio to the Vatican.

New Year's Day brought an enlightening trip to the Equator where we had a celebratory lunch of traditional Ugandan food. The following day, after a stop at the Ziwa Rhino sanctuary, the group arrived at the Murchison Falls Safari Reserve where they encountered baboons, giraffes, elephants, lions and other of God's magnificent creatures. Next on the itinerary was a trek through Budongo Forest where the rangers successfully led the group to observe chimpanzees in their natural environment. A cruise on the Nile River, which included multiple sightings of hippos, crocodiles, and colorful indigenous birds, concluded the group's amazing encounters with Uganda's wildlife. Even more amazing was the second half of the trip where the group

travelled to Fr. Patrick's hometown, Jinja – also home to the source of the Nile River. They were warmly welcomed at Fr. Patrick's childhood home for dinner and were able to meet Fr. Patrick's dad, sisters, and other family members.

Mass at Fr. Patrick's parish enabled the group to meet so many lovely people, including the children and widows of the parish and those who were seeking medical care made possible through Little by Little. The highlight of Jinja was spending time at the orphanage which is supported by Fr. Patrick's Never Give Up Foundation (<u>www.nevergiveupuganda.org</u>). The children enthusiastically greeted their visitors with song and dance and so appreciated the school supplies and clothing donated by OLPH's parishioners.

In addition, the group was able to witness, along with over 1,000 people, the Sisters of St. Francis of Assisi who were taking their perpetual vows and celebrating 25 and 50-year jubilees. Visits to Parliament (which included Mass) and to the Shrine of the Ugandan Martyrs educated the group on Uganda's political history and its devotion to Christianity.

Traveling to Uganda with Fr. Patrick was a life changing experience for all. Not only was the safari and wildlife encounters awe-inspiring, meeting the wonderful people of Uganda through Fr. Patrick was truly a joy and blessing.






