## seek, share, rejoice - pastor's letter...

Dear Parishioners,  
"Together we bring hope."

This is Commitment Weekend for the 2025 Annual Catholic Appeal. The theme of this year's appeal is, "Together in Hope", which echoes the theme of the Holy Year, "Pilgrims of Hope."

As we reflect on the theme of hope, as a parish, a diocese, and a universal Church, we are reminded

that our sense of belonging transcends family and parish to a much broader reality.

The Gospel from Luke presents a challenging case for the remarkable commitment it takes to be Christian. We are called to relinquish our need to be self-centered and in control. In fact, we are challenged to be a radical "other-centered" person. Love those you hate, pray for those who mistreat you, be merciful, stop judging others. "Give, and gifts will be given you."

This Gospel passage is not the easiest to hear. We are surrounded by voices that can be so mean spirited and selfish in tone. Just listen to the political rhetoric we are inundated with that borders on cruelty to those who are

different. Intolerance has been on the resurgence and the dignity of the human person is being dismissed for economic gain.

We need to embrace these challenging aspects of what it means to follow in the footsteps of Our Lord. Where do I need to challenge myself to be more loving, patient, and merciful? How do I participate in the building up of others rather than tearing them down? Where do I need to be reconciled and healed?

We are called to move away from just living for ourselves and being isolated to be a life-giving spirit for others. I see this being witnessed in a marriage where both spouses are committed to mutual love and care for one another. I see this witnessed in the unconditional love of a parent in which there is such generous presence to their children, I see this in the witness of service in ministry to the larger community.

If a Church is really a credible witness in the world, its mission must embrace the formation of people considering this weekend's Gospel mandate. We, together, grounded in Our Lord's proclamation of the Kingdom of God, seek to be a part of the transformation of the world. This is a process, in which each generation presents new issues, new challenges to apply the vision of Jesus' mandate to "love one another."





## Bill Thome - a tribute

April 9, 1932 – January 16, 2025

The Sharing Ministry recently lost one of our heroes, **Bill Thome**. He was a 6:00am fixture in the Sharing Resource Center (SRC) six days a week for over 20 years. He and **Ed Krupa** started each sharing day, organizing what had come in. They would then head to Trader Joe's where Bill organized and worked a daily effort to pick up and deliver day old goods from the store. These donations often fill two or more SUV's. Northfield Township Food Pantry, Niles Township Food Pantry, Sacred Heart Convent in Wilmette, Glenview Youth Services and other locations looked forward to his visits and appreciated these deliveries.

On Saturdays he and Ed picked up from Costco and ensured these items found their way to those in need. Sunday mornings found him volunteering as an usher at 6:30am, later 7:30am Mass, a service he performed for over 20 years. In between, he found time to serve with the Knights of Columbus on the OLPH Fr. Dussman Council. He was a 4th degree and served with the Knights for 27 years.

Though Bill retired at age 70, he did not pursue a retirement bucket list of adventures. He poured himself into deeper involvement with his kids and grandkids, stepped into big roles with Sharing and the parish. He continued working hard, but this time for God's family. Bill performed his ministry work into his 90's.

When physical challenges started slowing him down, he reported to the SRC with a walker or a cane, but he would be there. He would often ditch these walking aids and be lifting and moving about at risk, but his inner drive to work and make a difference would always override his personal needs. Nothing would hold him back.

One day, making a run to Sacred Heart Convent with a full load of produce from Trader Joe's, there was an accident. Bill's car was totaled and he was hospitalized. In the face of this adversity, Bill's primary concern was the produce that was still in his car. He only found peace when he learned that a Sharing team had rescued the food from his impounded vehicle.

Bill, through his humility, patience, kindness, dedication, joyful spirit, compassion, perseverance, gentleness, and faithfulness, left his mark on all who had the privilege to work with him.
