Dear Parishioners,

"Yes Lord, you know that I love you."

During these weeks of Easter, our Gospels will recount Jesus' post resurrection appearances. They are all remarkable moments when the apostles and the disciples, consumed in their grief, find their eyes are opened to the extraordinary realization that Jesus has risen.

Jesus chose to reveal his risen presence as a moment of reassurance, he chose not retribution. He could have appeared to confront Pontius Pilate who had condemned him to death, he could have appeared to the Sanhedrin to declare he was indeed the Son of God. He could have tormented those who laughed at him or beat him on the Way to the Cross, He could have had crucified the one who placed the crown of thorns upon his head.

No, the Way of the Lord is a journey of love, and mercy.

Not only do we need to be reassured but so does the Lord. In this beautiful Gospel we hear proclaimed this weekend, the Lord asks Peter three times, "do you love me?" Each time Peter responds, "Yes Lord, you know I love you." True discipleship is a two-way street, we proclaim the Lord's love for us, and we affirm our love for the Risen Christ.

There can be no greater expression of that love than the Eucharist. The Lord gives of us his very being to feed us. The grace of the Eucharist enables us to move into the world as an authentic witness.

This weekend and next weekend we celebrate four First Communion Masses for our second graders in the school and Religious Education. We rejoice for each of these children and their families. We celebrate the Eucharistic community of our parish expanding with each child who makes their First Communion. I am grateful for the support of our parents, teachers and catechists who have helped to make this day possible.

It has been such a joy seeing those who were received into the Church on Holy Saturday at Mass on these weekends of the Easter Season. All thirteen of you are a blessing to us. Your youthfulness brings such energy to OLPH. I cannot wait to get to know you better.

Thank you to everyone who has made a gift or is considering a gift to our **Generation to Generation: Answer the Call** capital campaign. I have great news we have now surpassed our set goal of 3.75 million dollars and are now on our way to reach our stretch goal of six million dollars. We can do it! By making this goal we can accomplish our projects that will make our campus more beautiful, safer, and more accessible. These projects benefit us all. We will be passing out packets to those who have not received them, and we will be hearing witness talks after communion this weekend.

Work on the renovation of McDonnell Hall is in full swing. The demolition of the interior space is taking place. By the time we are finished we will have a wonderful, up to date space for our 9:30am family Mass, gatherings, meetings, scouting events and formation events. It will be equipped with a new sound system, the best digital equipment, and an updated kitchen. We will have new lighting and a new HVAC system; it will be a great asset to our future parish life, Thank you for your generous support of this project.

I received a wonderful letter from **Fr. Carlos Collazo Santiago** who preached here recently about the Church in Puerto Rico and Our Lady of Perpetual Help in Salinas Puerto Rico. He was deeply grateful for our spiritual and financial support. OLPH Puerto Rico was our Lenten almsgiving project. The children collected money throughout Lent and our second collection that weekend went to the parish.

The annual Men's Club Kickoff event is this week, I am so grateful to **Danny McDonnell**, the officers and membership. The Men's Club made a major gift to the capital campaign and supports so many ministries of the parish. It has been a terrific year of drawing new members.






