Dear Parishioners,

"The disciples were filled with joy and the Holy Spirit."

The Easter Season is grounded in a sense of profound joy. It begins with the discovery of the empty tomb on Easter Morning. As the days of the Easter Season unfold, we cannot help but experience joy as the reality of the Lord's Resurrection is revealed to more of his disciples.

On a parallel track we recall the joy and power of the Holy Spriit driving those first believers to witness to their faith and to call others to Easter faith. The passages from the Acts of the Apostles are really an account of the genealogy of the Church as we know it today. It was the likes of Paul, Barnabas, Peter and the first believers who laid the foundation of what we now come to call the one, catholic, apostolic and universal church. The first believers transcended all the religious categories of what it meant to belong to the "Way," the followers of Jesus the Christ.

There has been much written and studied as to what led to the explosive growth of the Christian community in the first and second centuries. This especially is a point of interest to scholars as to how many pagans left their religious practices to embrace the gospel of Jesus Christ.

One element of consensus was the powerful witness of the first believers to Jesus' mandate to "love one another as I have loved you." In a highly judgmental culture and an obsession with following mythical gods, they saw first-hand a group of faith filled people who gave food to the hungry, shelter to the homeless, a sense of communal responsibility for those in need. It transcended self-centeredness, greed, and self-preservation. "We are better together!"

This Fourth Sunday of Easter is called Good Shepherd Sunday. We hear references in the Gospel to Jesus as the Good Shepherd. "My sheep hear my voice." As an Easter people with joy and the power of the Holy Spirit we strive to hear the "voice" of the Shepherd. How can we capture the counter cultural courage that marked those first believers?

This weekend the second collection is for the Mother Day's collection to support Catholic Charities. Last year, Catholic Charities help assisted 61,000 moms and children with the resources raised. OLPH has had a long history of supporting the efforts of Catholic Charities to reduce the scourge of poverty in Cook and Lake counties.

On the subject of Mother's Day, I extend my greetings on this day for all women who give life, nurture life, who advocate on behalf of the vulnerable. May this Mother's Day be filled with many expressions of gratitude and affection for the critical part you play in all our lives.

Congratulations to all our Religious Education candidates who will make their First Communion this Saturday. We are so proud of every one of you!

May is Mary's month. Being a parish under the patronage of the Blessed Mother we rejoice in her intercession for us. Please feel free to place flowers at the foot of the statue of the Blessed Mother in the Hellerman Garden. We had a lovely May Crowning last Sunday that was hosted by our Religious Education program.

Work is moving forward on McDonnell Hall. It is a project with many moving parts. We are hoping to keep moving forward with the renovation process. Thank you for your patience. We have a great construction crew. When it is finished it will serve us all for generations to come.

Thank you for your consideration of the capital campaign, "Generation to Generation: Answer the Call." We have broken through the 4-million-dollar mark on our way to six million. Thanks to everyone who have already made a commitment to the campaign. From now on 80% of the money pledged remains to fund our projects here at OLPH. With your support, OLPH will be a more beautiful, more accessible, safer, and more welcoming place for years to come. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact me. I am grateful for the powerful witnesses that were given last weekend by John Clifford, Dave Ludden, Jen Riordan, and Bob Michels.

As I write this letter there is tremendous anticipation surrounding the opening of the papal conclave in Rome. The New Pope may have already been elected by the time you read this. "Come Holy Spirit, Renew the face of the Earth."

Last Tuesday marked the end of the mourning period for the passing of Pope Francis. On Wednesday May 7, a special Mass was offered at OLPH for the election of the new Roman Pontiff. The Mass is called "Pro Eligendo Romano Pontifice" and was celebrated by **Fr. Jeremiah Boland.**

This papal display highlights the importance of the papacy in the life of the Catholic Church. As the successor of St. Peter, the Pope serves as the visible head of the universal Church and a sign of unity among Catholics around the world.

Through his teachings, guidance, and witness, the Holy Father helps us stay rooted in the Gospel and connected to the faith passed down through the centuries. This display invites us to reflect on the Pope's role as a shepherd who leads us closer to Christ and calls us to live our faith with courage, love, and joy.


