Dear Parishioners,

"Behold, I make all things new."

The glory of the Easter Season is the promise that all can be new, all can be forgiven, we can all begin again. It is the season of unbridled hope. The realization that what seems impossible is possible.

There can be moments in the heart of winter that you find yourself longing for Spring, Will the tulips ever bloom again? In the

heart of the Lenten season when we face the reality of sin in our life, can I ever be forgiven, can I get over some of the painful memories of my past?


