Dear Parishioners,

""Do not let your hearts be troubled or afraid."

The great theologian and reggae musician, **Bob Marley** wrote a song in 1977 entitled, "*Three Little Birds*", with the lyrics, "*don't worry bout a thing because everything is going to be alright.*" Wouldn't it be great if we could move through life without worrying about things? I suspect most of us have more than

enough to worry about from the mundane to the profound. From "I am running so late I hope I do not get stopped by the train on Glenview Road" to "What am I going to do if that biopsy is positive?"

We have different degrees of anxiety that surround the things we worry about. Some things we have no control over and others we do. This time of year, students worry about final exams and research papers. There are graduates worrying about the job market. There are families struggling with financial concerns. Some worry about an elderly parent who is struggling to cope. Health issues and work issues can consume us. Some worry about our political culture and international instability. There is a lot to worry about!

The scriptures this weekend address this reality. The Lord is not denying the fact that worries can consume us. He points out a way to live with the force of worry in a healthier way. He invites us to bring our worries and concerns to him in prayer. Through prayer the things that are tearing us apart can be diminished and resolved. We can cope better, we can feel not so alone, or overwhelmed.

In the first reading, Paul and Barnabas were feeling tremendous worry over the future of the emerging church regarding the inclusion of non-Jewish members. This issue was tearing the Church apart. Some saw Christianity as a sect within Judaism and others saw the community of believers as a new and distinct reality.

Peter convened the Apostles and the Elders, which included Paul and Barnabas. They all came to Jerusalem and Peter invoked the Holy Spirit. They resolved the crises with a renewed sense of purpose and mission. Everyone could belong!

The Lord comforts us with his assurance, you will never have to be troubled or afraid that I am not with you. While the Lord ascended to heaven, his Risen Presence has and will never abandon us!!

Everything is going to be all right!

I am so proud of all our graduates. To all our eighth graders, high school seniors and college graduates, Congratulations! Take the time to appreciate this accomplishment. You matter and you will make a difference. God has blest you with many gifts. Use those gifts and celebrate them! The world needs you.

Thank you to everyone who has pledged a gift to our capital campaign, "*Generation to Generation: Answer the Call.*" We have surpassed the 4.8-million-dollar mark and are 80% on the way to our six-million-dollar goal. Thank you for your tremendous commitment to the future of our parish. I know many are discerning whether they will participate. I appreciate very much your time for consideration. I know you have many claims on your resources. Each pledge we receive broadens the base of parishioners, feeling part of this effort. Thank you so much!

McDonnell Hall is making progress. We are in that tedious phase of the project which is making choices regarding infrastructure concerns. I get so excited seeing the project evolve and the significant difference this space will make to parish life.

Some have been wondering about why there is a tent in front of the Rectory. Good Question! We are trying to accommodate several activities that would normally be taking place in McDonnell Hall. We have activities related to graduation, summer camp, outdoor liturgies and other events that really appreciate the tent.

Congratulations to our Director of Finance and Operations, **Mary Lynne Januszewski's** son **Mark**, who has been named CSL South Baseball Coach of the Year. He has coached at Deerfield High School for many years and is so respected.

Last week we had our annual joint meeting of the Parish Pastoral Council and the Parish Finance Council. It has been a wonderful year and there is much to look forward to next year. Our parish is blessed by the generous and dedicated leadership of our councils.

We have completed our process of preparing the school and parish budgets. They are about to be submitted to the Archdiocese. Controlling expenses and financial management will help us meet this year's budget and we will forecast a 3% increase in collections to meet the cost of living for next year. Thank you for your faithful stewardship of OLPH.




