Dear Parishioners,

"The Spirit enabled them to proclaim."

The Easter Season draws to a close with the Feast of Pentecost. One of the ancient rituals observed on Pentecost Sunday is the last intonation, "the Mass is ended, go in peace, Alleluia, Alleluia!" Then the priest or deacon processes out of the sanctuary holding the paschal candle that had been blest and lit on Holy Saturday.

The symbolism is profound, emboldened by the recalling of Our Lord's passion, death, and resurrection, formed by the 50 days of Easter, we now must bring the proclamation of the Good News into the world.

The Christian faith is not a solitary affair. We worship and live out our faith in community, in relationship with one another. It is a bond that transcends race, culture, language, even history. As we read in this week's scripture from the Acts of the Apostles, "filled with the Holy Spirit, they began to speak in different tongues, as the Spirit enabled them to proclaim."

Often on Sundays as I look out at the congregation, I marvel at this context that brings us together in ways that we would not normally assemble. Here we are, the young and the old, the old-timer and the newcomer, the wealthy and the poor, insiders, and outsiders, those in joy and those in sorrow. We live in a world where, social capital, the coming together of people is diminishing. Our Eucharistic worship is a defiant stance against individualism, aloneness, self-centeredness.

Building bridges, working together, looking out for one another's wellbeing is the Christian challenge. Selfishness, greed, self-righteousness, unbridled self-interest has no place in a community driven by and led by the Holy Spirit.

May this Pentecost usher in a new era of hope and commitment to our community here at OLPH.

This weekend we celebrate the ministry of **Fr. Patrick Kizza** and **Fr. Larry Basbas**. What a blessing they have

been to us here at the parish. They came to us as newly ordained priests and we have seen them both flourish and thrive as priests. They embody for me the theme of this week's liturgy, "the Spirit enabled them to proclaim." Fr. Patrick and Fr. Larry were enabled by the Holy Spirit. They represent such hope for me. They have grown in the priesthood; they have blest us and we have blest them!

Our parish has served the Church in many ways. I am aware this weekend of the influence this parish has had on seminarians and newly ordained priests. Getting off to a good start in any profession is critical. I thank you for the interest and generosity you have always extended to seminarians and newly ordained priests. This parish has shared in the formation of these guys that is essential to their future as ordained priests. There is a fraternity out there of priests who cherish the fact that at a crucial period of their life, OLPH was instrumental in who they became. Thank you!

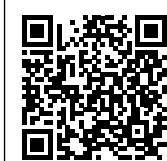
