Dear Parishioners,

"Hope does not disappoint."

This weekend the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. The dogma of the Trinity has been a source of theological dialogue from the earliest days. The Gospel of John is centered on this essential conviction that the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit live in relationship and reveal the

profound mystery of God at work in the creator, the redeemer, and the Spirit.

This profound revelation that our God lives in relationship, three persons and One God is at the foundation of our religious heritage.

This year marks the 1700th anniversary of the Nicene Creed which in 325 AD became the creedal expression of the Christian Church. It centers on our belief in the Trinity: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. One of **Pope Leo's** first trips as Pope will be to travel to Turkey to mark the anniversary. He will gather with the leaders of most Christian communities to celebrate this anniversary and to express the dream of one day unity within the Christian family. He wants to see the celebration of this anniversary as an expression of the Year of Jubilee; we are pilgrims of hope. "Hope does not disappoint as we hear proclaimed in the scriptures of this weekend.

A great experience of hope was when the senior cardinal stepped onto the balcony of St. Peter's Basilica and announced *Habemus Papam!* We have a Pope! It was then we learned the Cardinal Prevost, of Chicago roots, would become the 267th successor of St. Peter.

This past week I was tempted to step out on the front steps of Our Lady of Perpetual Help Church and proclaim *Habemus Presbyteros!* We have priests! I received word from the Cardinal's office that he has appointed two new associate pastors to OLPH. We are so blessed.

Fr. Honoratus Mwageni and **Fr. Roy Belocura** will begin on July 1. I had excellent interviews with them, and they both come highly recommended. You will be hearing much more about them in the coming weeks.

I am so grateful for the support of **Cardinal Cupich**, **Fr. Mike Knotek**, the Director of Priest Personnel, and **Carol Walters**, the Cardinal's Delegate for Externs for their great support of our parish in recommending these two wonderful priests.

Last week's celebration of the ministry of **Fr. Patrick Kizza** and **Fr. Lary Basbas** was terrific. Thanks to our choir and all those involved that made for such a glorious

celebration of their priesthood. I am beyond words in appreciation to **Mary Fran Dolan** and **Beth O'Grady** for organizing such an awesome reception.

This weekend is crucial to the success of our capital campaign, "Generation to Generation: Answer the Call." We will invite everyone to consider a pledge or to affirm the pledge they have made.

As of this writing we are at 5.8 million dollars towards our 6-million-dollar goal. I hope we can get to 800 parishioners participating. This is the weekend we can close the gap between these two formidable benchmarks. We can do it!!

If you have not pledged yet, please consider supporting the campaign. It is so fitting that we make this leadership commitment on Trinity Sunday, which is all about relationships. With your support, we as a parish family can make a transformational investment in the future of OLPH. With your support, the OLPH of tomorrow will be a safer, more accessible, more beautiful and a more welcoming parish. The more of us in the "game" will impact everyone's sense of belonging.

I know this campaign has required a lot of time and focus. Thank you for your patience and support. We just need to do a full court press to include everyone.

Whatever you can do makes a difference! Every gift brings us closer, as a parish family and closer to investing in our parish, a place we all love and benefit from.

Those of you who know me, know this fund-raising process is really hard for me. You all support this parish and its mission so generously. I struggle with having to invite you to consider making a special sacrifice for our future.

This parish never fails to step up when we need to. I cannot put into words how overwhelmed I am by your incredible generosity and how committed you are to our faith community.

We have just a few weeks to go and we will begin the implementation of the projects of the campaign. We will then begin to determine how to proceed by making sure that every dollar you have pledged will accomplish our goals.

In fact, 80% of every dollar stays here at OLPH and the remaining 20% supports that efforts of the diocese to care for priests, support our financially challenged parishes and to invest in programs to encourage spiritual renewal.
