

Dear Parishioners,

"Do this in remembrance of me." We did it!!

I am beyond words to thank you for your tremendous support of our capital campaign, "Generation to Generation: Answer the Call." We have surpassed the 6-milliondollar mark. Last week's response to the leadership weekend was

unbelievable with almost a half million dollars raised. One of the largest single weekend efforts of any parish.

We are still accepting pledges, the more we raise, the bigger the cushion to protect us from inflation and tariff increases on products we will need for the construction projects. The more parishioners that participate, the greater ownership we will all have in this transformational effort to ensure a bright future here at OLPH and for generations to come.

As I visited with many parishioners as part of the process I was continually blown away by stories and experiences of the incredible place OLPH has in their hearts. We are a blessed community! Time and time again you have responded spiritually as well as financially, to our parish's needs. Not a week goes by that I do not hear a story of parishioners going above and beyond in reaching out to a family in need or in crisis.

I am deeply indebted to the chair couples and the volunteers who made all this happen.

Some of my brother pastors have asked me, "how does OLPH do it"? At the center of our parish life is the Eucharist. Without centering our parish life on the Eucharist, much of what we do would have much less impact and meaning.

"Do this in remembrance of me" are the profound words proclaimed at every Mass. As we hear those words we are reminded that our central mission as Christians is to remember the Lord! In the breaking of the bread and the sharing of the cup we are fed and renewed in our desire to be more Christ like and authentic in our witness.

I along with the other presiders have the privilege of leading this wonderful parish in the celebration of the Mass. We are joined by our wonderful music ministry under the leadership of **Russell Stern**. Our lectors, servers, greeters, and ushers are all coordinated by **Margie André**. Our wonderful liturgy committee plans and executes our liturgies throughout the year with a special focus on the liturgical seasons. Our digital ministry brings our celebrations to the home bound and all those who for whatever reason are unable to attend. We are also blessed by our Deacons.

This Corpus Christi weekend is an opportunity to renew our love of the Eucharist. With the arrival of our two associates, **Fr. Honoratus** and **Fr. Roy**, we will not have to make any


changes in our mass schedules. Thank Goodness!






