## seek, share, rejoice - pastor's letter...

Dear Parishioners,

"What must I do to inherit eternal life?"

The question the scholar posed to Jesus in this week's gospel is a heavy one to consider on a hot summer weekend. Ultimate questions about the meaning of life, the purpose of life, the goal of the Christian journey are never far from the surface of life.

What must I do? Jesus frames his answer to a question that could easily become very theoretical to the very practical. "They will know they are Christians by their love" was a refrain of an old Catholic hymn from the 60's, When I was hungry you fed me. The parable of the Good Samaritan makes the Christian answer to the above question very real, very practical.

Keeping it real is a challenge. In the end, how did our choices, our behaviors, our priorities reveal one who was seeking eternal life?

We need to develop our spiritual life, we need to avail ourselves of the sacraments, the Word of God must feed us, but we must also act on the invitation of the Lord to "love one another." I see so much evidence of this faith filled with generous love by you! I am always moved by the selfless love parents share with their children; I see the sacrament of marriage come alive when one spouse embraces their beloved during hospice. I see it when someone drives bags of groceries from the Sharing Room to a food pantry so a single mom on the south side can feed her family.

Being a "Good Samaritan" is much more than an oftenused slogan. It is a life altering stance one takes in how one relates to the world. I reach out to others not because it is a nice thing to do, I do it because I am a Christian and I am seeking eternal life.

**Cardinal George** described this challenge by saying, "all you will have in heaven is what you gave away while on earth" He was talking about much more than money and material things. How about the time you gave away so as to be there for others, how about the energy you gave away to avoid arguing and complaining, how about the sacrifices you made so others could have a better life? How about the ego you gave away to be a kinder, more compassionate person?

Well, our first tent Mass went great last week. Don't forget we now have an outdoor Mass at 9:30am on the Rectory lawn. I know the weather is always unpredictable but unless it is really bad, we are going with it because we have nowhere else to go! We had a wonderful celebration with the chair couples and volunteers for our capital campaign: "*Generation to Generation: Answer the Call.*" We have surpassed the 7-million-dollar mark. I am so deeply grateful for your sacrifices and investment in the future of OLPH. We are still seeking pledges. The more parishioners who have participated the more we will feel part of this gift to future generations of OLPH. Added resources help buffer us from unexpected increases due to inflation and cost of living. We will be able to replace an air conditioning unit in one of the buildings that has failed and needs to be up and running.

OLPH has always risen to the moment, and this capital campaign is yet another great example of this amazing parish.

I will soon be setting up a steering committee that will oversee the budgeting process for our projects and a prioritization and timeline for accomplishing them. You can expect regular updates. If you are still considering a pledge, please contact me or **Mary Lynne Januszewski** at the parish office to assist you.

Next weekend we will be installing the members of the Parish Pastoral Council at the 9:00am Mass. We will also have coffee and doughnuts after the Masses to welcome our two new associates, **Fr. Honoratus** and **Fr. Roy**. Please stop by and say hello.

I was born in Tanzania in 1963 to a Catholic family of 12 siblings. Two of us are priests and two of our sisters are Benedictine nuns. I was ordained on July 20, 1997 in Rwanda. I have served in Rwanda in different parishes as associate pastor and as pastor for ten years before coming to the United States for studies at Loyola University Chicago. After graduating with master's degree in Social Justice and Community Development, I was assigned to serve in a parish.

I have served at St. Basil Visitation Church as a parish priest for one year, and then St Helena of the Cross as administrator for one year, at SS. Peter and Paul as administrator for 12 years, and at Our Lady of Kibeho as an associate pastor for 3 years.

I am involved in the Missionary Cooperation Plan to help the people of Rwanda who are still in need of recovery from the 1994 genocide. We evangelize them through Catholic education so that the country may heal and have a brighter future.

My education achievements also include a Bachelor of Philosophy, Bachelor Arts in Religious, and Doctor of Education.

I am glad I have joined this wonderful family of Our Lady of Perpetual Help. I am ready to learn and to work together with all of you, so that we may support one another as we continue with this journey of faith under the wonderful leadership of our Pastor Fr. Jeremiah Boland. My motto is "Your will be done" (Fiat Voluntas Tua).

### "God has a better plan. Every time!"

I could describe my 45 years of existence in this world as a series of me having a good plan, then God leading me to a better one.

My name was to be given by my dad, Marcos Belocura, Jr, and it was supposed to be Nicandro, but according to my mom, Anastacia Domondon, my dad was not around when the hospital needed the newborn baby's name after I was born on March 15, 1980, in Davao City, the Philippines. God must have inspired my mom to utter "Roy" for my first name, which means "king" in honor of Christ the King, the titular of my home diocese, Diocese of Tagum, Davao del Norte.

I am the youngest of three - my sister Telma being the oldest and my brother Marcos III being the middle. My dad passed away in 1986 when I was only five years old. My mom made it to my ordination to priesthood on April 26, 2011, but she did not make it to my first anniversary. Despite the difficult life of being a single-parent, by God's grace my mom did a great job raising us all to finish school and have college degrees.

I wanted to become a TV or radio commentator, but the associate pastor of my home parish in New Bataan, Davao de Oro, was able to convince me that I could do even more than what I dreamed of if I would become a priest. I entered Queen of Apostles College Seminary, then to San Jose Seminary in Ateneo de Manila University. God led me to get ordained as a priest in 2011 for the Diocese of Tagum.

I loved my priestly ministry in the Diocese of Tagum. But then, God had a better plan for me which led me to the US in 2017. Now I am serving God's people halfway around the world from where I was born. From 2017 to 2022, I served as associate pastor at St. Mary Parish in Des Plaines; from 2022 to 2025 at St. Julie Billiart Parish in Tinley Park. Now here I am with you; who would not love to be part of this community in and through whom God is doing so many good things.

### Mission Appeal for the Diocese of Ootacamund (India)

On the weekend of July 19 & 20, **Fr. Thomas Rayar**, a native of India currently serving in Minnesota, will be at OLPH to make an appeal for the Diocese of Ootacamund, India.

The diocese of Ootacamund was established in 1955 in the mountainous area of Tamil Nadu State in India by Pope Pius XII. It has a Catholic population of c.98,000 which would be 5% of the total population of that area. About 150 priests and 415 religious nuns serve in 67 parishes and 226 mission stations and 22 high schools in this diocese. About two third of the faithful of the diocese are illiterate and mostly daily-wage laborers and farmers earning about \$4 a day with which the families cannot afford to send their children to school.

Apart from people with different cultures, the diocese is enriched with different aboriginal tribes both in Nilgiris mountains and Erode districts. These tribal people do not have opportunities for education. More than 38% of the population are illiterate. As there are no proper roads to the hilly tribal villages, we have established boarding schools in the towns where the tribal children could have education.

By God's grace, we have been blessed with a great number of vocations for priests and nuns. However, with our meagre resources we find it difficult to support our Seminarians to prepare for their priesthood.

The funds raised from this appeal will specifically be spent for educational expenses of these poor children in the orphanages and for the education of the seminarians of our diocese. Thank you for your generosity! May God bless you for your sacrificial support to the mission and your prayers for evangelization of our global Church!
