## seek, share, rejoice - pastor's letter...

Dear Parishioners,

"You are anxious and worried about many things."

This weekend's gospel passage about Jesus' visit with Martha and Mary has been one of the most reflected upon encounters. We all have "Martha's" and "Mary's" in our lives.

One of the more debilitating forces in life is stress. It can eat

away at our emotional, spiritual, and physical wellbeing. There are of course many sources of stress and a wide range of degrees of how stressed we are.

Anxiety about the "worries" of life can be all consuming. We may have financial worries, relationship worries, worries about the future, or worries about the consequences of the past, worries about our health or the health of a loved one.

We all have our ways of coping. We all know the blessed gift of friendship. Hopefully, we all have people in our lives that we can come clean or be unvarnished about what is really going on in our life.

Many people try to "go it alone" when dealing with stressful situations and that rarely works out. Cultivating friendships is a gift and a necessity to healthy living.

I was at a conference recently for priests turning 70 years old. I just joined the 70 and older club! One of the presenters challenged us to keep making friends. As a person gets older their social circle begins to shrink. Making new friends is never easy but is an important goal.

This story of Martha and Mary speaks to me about how important it is to forge a sense of balance in life between being and doing.

Our spiritual life can be a great source of strength in countering the stresses and worries of life. The Lord seeks to be our companion by discovering the power of his love and grace. Never take for granted the power of prayer in facing our challenges.

This weekend we will focus our annual Mission Appeal on the needs of the Diocese of Ootacamund, India. I am delighted to welcome **Bishop Amalraj** and **Fr. Tom Rayer** who will be preaching at our Masses. The diocese faces the challenges of significant poverty and illiteracy. Funds raised from the mission appeal will be used to provide more opportunities for the very poor to receive an education. Thank you for your consideration!

At the 9:00am Mass we will be installing the Parish Pastoral Council. The PPC is one of the major governance structures in the parish. I rely so much on their guidance and wisdom. This parish has been blessed year after year by an outstanding parish council. Over the year, we face so many issues that need to be sorted out or responded to. They help me keep a perspective of the big picture in terms of our sense of mission and direction. **Michael Crowe** is our president and does a great job.

This coming year will be a busy one and a challenging one. We will begin the first phase of implementing the "Generation to Generation" capital campaign and they will play a critical role in the discernment of the new pastor by next summer.

Speaking of the capital campaign, "Generation to Generation," thank you for your generous support of the campaign. **We passed the 7.1-million-dollar mark**.

We are still accepting pledges! OLPH was a record breaker on many levels for the first wave of the campaign. I can see now why the Archdiocese wanted us to be on the first wave. We raised the most money, we exceeded our goal as of this week by 190%, over six hundred pledges by far the most of any parish up to date. Your generosity never ceases to amaze me! I soon will be establishing a steering committee that will set budgets for the projects and determine the schedule of projects. This will depend on how much money we collect and have on hand. Because the campaign is a 5-year process, it will take patience to tackle the projects with this reality in mind.

This weekend there will be coffee and donuts after many of the Masses to welcome our two new associates: **Fr. Honoratus** and **Fr. Roy**. Please stop by and say hello!

McDonnell Hall continues to move forward, Work is beginning in framing the ceiling, plumbing work for the bathrooms and kitchen, and preparing for the placement of a generator and HVAC equipment along the northern exterior of the church.

## seek, share, rejoice - upcoming events and programs ...

#### Mission Appeal for the Diocese of Ootacamund (India)

On the weekend of July 19 & 20, **Fr. Thomas Rayar**, a native of India currently serving in Minnesota, will be at OLPH to make an appeal for the Diocese of Ootacamund, India.

The diocese of Ootacamund was established in 1955 in the mountainous area of Tamil Nadu State in India by Pope Pius XII. It has a Catholic population of c.98,000 which would be 5% of the total population of that area. About 150 priests and 415 religious nuns serve in 67 parishes and 226 mission stations and 22 high schools in this diocese. About two third of the faithful of the diocese are illiterate and mostly daily-wage laborers and farmers earning about \$4 a day with which the families cannot afford to send their children to school.

Apart from people with different cultures, the diocese is enriched with different aboriginal tribes both in Nilgiris mountains and Erode districts. These tribal people do not have opportunities for education. More than 38% of the population are illiterate. As there are no proper roads to the hilly tribal villages, we have established boarding schools in the towns where the tribal children could have education.

By God's grace, we have been blessed with a great number of vocations for priests and nuns. However, with our meagre resources we find it difficult to support our Seminarians to prepare for their priesthood.

The funds raised from this appeal will specifically be spent for educational expenses of these poor children in the orphanages and for the education of the seminarians of our diocese. Thank you for your generosity! May God bless you for your sacrificial support to the mission and your prayers for evangelization of our global Church!
