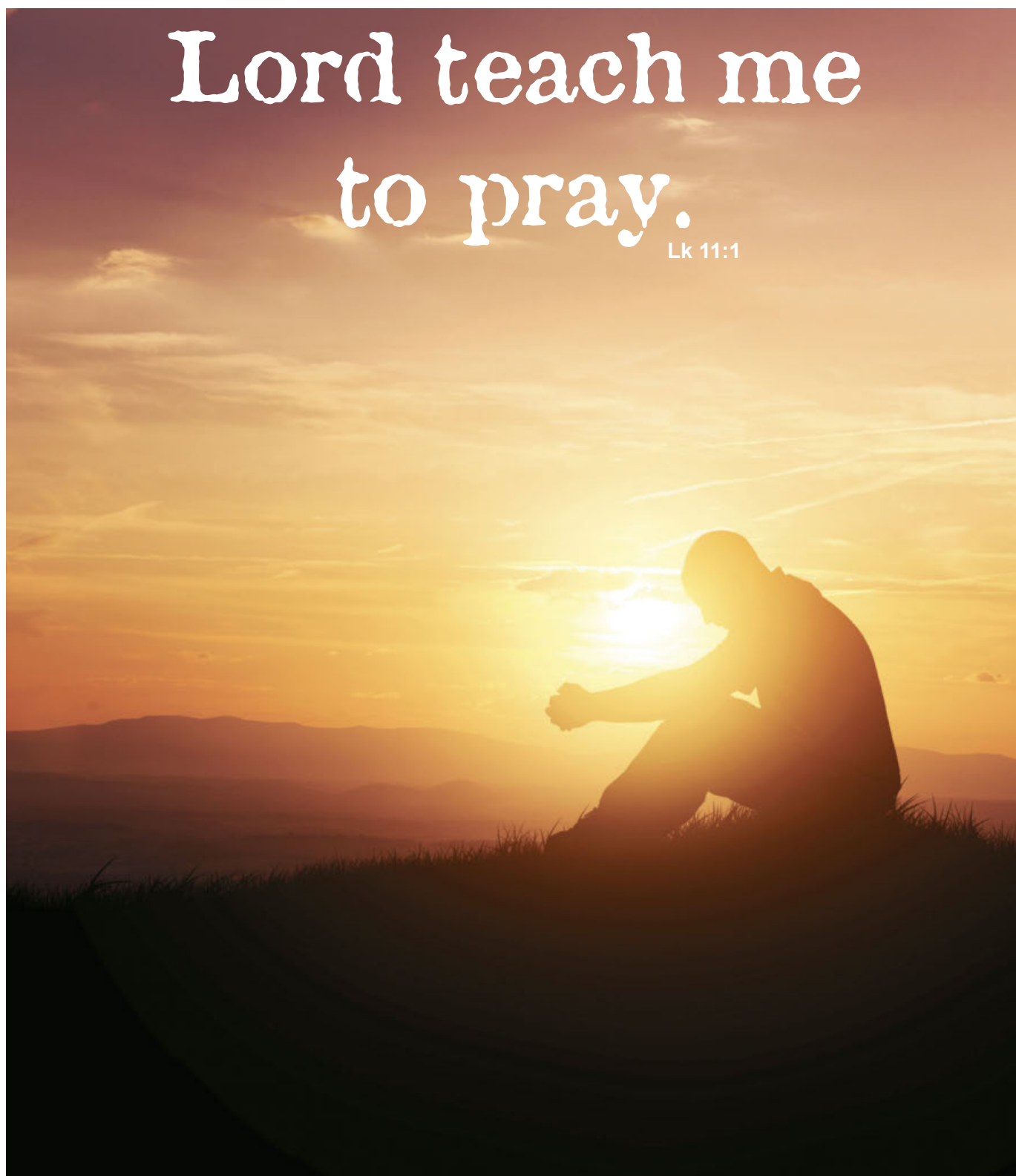

Dear Parishioners,
"Lord teach me to pray."

One of the ancient churches in Jerusalem is the Church of the Pater Noster. The original church dates to the fourth century. There is a grotto here near the Mount of Olives where tradition has it Jesus taught the disciples, the Our Father (Pater Noster). Along the walls of the monastery are plaques that display the Our Father in over one hundred languages and dialects. Pilgrims are always delighted when they discover the plaque that displays the Our Father in their native tongue.

The Our Father, the Lord's Prayer, is one of the first prayers most of us learn as children. It is a prayer that is etched into our psyche. For many of us, when all is said and done the most often repeated prayer in our lifetime will be the Our Father.

As a priest, and I suspect many of our Care Ministers have discovered over the years, no matter how sick a person is, no matter how pervasive their dementia may be, no matter how disoriented a person may be, once you start praying the Our Father, you can tell they are trying to mouth the words, our just have this sense they are feeling enormous comfort hearing those very familiar words.

Despite the many differences within the Christian community, most Christian denominations share a familiar version of the Our Father.

I remember some years ago attending a liturgy at the Chaldean Catholic Church in Northbrook and was deeply moved when the priest prayed the Our Father in Aramaic, the language Jesus spoke and the language the Our Father was uttered in for the first time.

Developing a strong prayer life, no matter what words we use is essential to a vibrant spiritual life. There are times when our prayers flow easily, other times when each syllable is a struggle.

We need to keep working at deepening our prayer life. It has so many benefits for the quality of life. Increased research indicates that people who pray recover more quickly than those who do not. More doctors ask their patients if they pray.

Psychologists report that people who incorporate daily periods of meditation deal with stress and anxiety in a far healthier way. People making major decisions regarding the direction of their life feel more at peace if that discernment is accompanied by prayer.

At Mass, I always feel a special bond or connection as I see all of us praying together, standing together, speaking the words of the prayer Jesus himself said and taught.

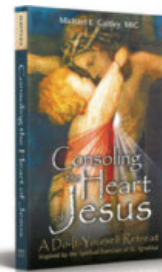

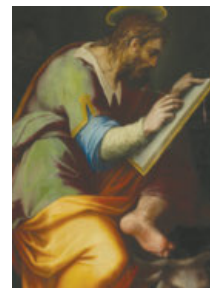
