This week's gospel from Luke contains a lot of wisdom. It invites us to reassess what is ultimately of value. All the possessions and the money in the world cannot guarantee happiness, inner peace, healthy relationships, or a purposeful life.

Summer Updates from OLPH's Seminarian Teaching Parish Program

While our seminarians Jeff Davlin, Charlie Leidel, and Andrew Whipple have been on summer break from their studies at Mundelein, they have been busy with interesting ministries and spiritual formation. Here's a look at what each has been up to:



Jeff: This summer I participated in a program for diocesan seminarians with the Institute of Priestly Formation (IPF) at Creighton University in Omaha, Nebraska. The program began with an eight-day silent retreat and focused primarily on human and spiritual formation. I experienced great closeness with the Lord and growth in my relationship with Him, especially

during the silent retreat.

I have now completed the program and returned to Grand Rapids, where I plan to spend time with family and serve at my home parish until the beginning of the fall semester. I miss OLPH and look forward to seeing everyone soon! Blessings.



Charlie: I worked at a Grand Rapids nursing home offering spiritual care to the elderly. It was beautiful to walk with residents as they journey toward the end of their pilgrimage. I found it an honor to bring them Christ's love and remind them how precious they are in His eyes. I also did some prison ministry, celebrating a communion service for the inmates and talking to

them about the faith. It amazes me how much Christ is already at work there and how I am able to witness His love even in a prison. After my final week of ministry I'll visit my sister in Colorado before heading back to Mundelein for my final semester. God bless you!



Andrew: I have been working at the Mission Our Lady of the Angels in West Humboldt Park since the end of May. My time there began with a Sister's final vows, which was beautiful to witness. A cohort of young adult volunteers joined me, and together we supported the Franciscans at the Mission in a variety of projects, events, and retreats. We helped set up and run the weekly food

pantry that serves thousands of locals. As counselors for the local YMCA camp, we've had great fun playing sports and games with some excited, energized kids!

I have seen Christ at work in the labors and the joys of the Mission where He has been a consistent presence and a true grace. In the Franciscans of the Eucharist and Bishop Bob Lombardo, I have witnessed how to build community, live the Catholic faith, and joyfully serve our brothers and sisters in the Church and beyond. Soon I will return to Mundelein and OLPH. I am looking forward to reconnecting with the parish, meeting the new priests and exchanging the graces of a season gone, as always, too quickly.

Did You Know?

Mundelein Seminary's stated mission is to form parish priests who are "Formed in Tradition, Trained in Compassion, Prepared to Shepherd." But what does it mean to be "trained in compassion"?



Last month, we toured Mundelein's innovative simulation lab that is focused on preparing seminarians to deliver more effective pastoral care. The Cor luxta Meum Center, led by Executive Director Marie

Pitt-Payne, incorporates elements of compassion science into the curriculum to help seminarians become more aware of their emotions during encounters with parishioners. The idea was influenced by the success top medical schools experienced with the inclusion of compassionate care in their curricula.

During a simulation, the seminarian meets in a realistic setting with a "parishioner" played by a professionally-trained actor. The "parishioner' role-plays a specific scenario a parish priest is likely to encounter.

The seminarian's formation advisor observes through a oneway mirror while a simulation operator records the encounter and manages cameras and audio. Once the encounter is complete, the seminarian completes a self-assessment and meets with his formation advisor to debrief.

The process not only helps the seminarian develop stronger interpersonal skills, but also increases his awareness of his own emotions during the encounter. The goal is to help the seminarian better manage his emotions and be fully present in order to provide the best possible pastoral care to his future parishioners.
