

Dear Parishioners,

"Where your treasure is, there also will your heart be."

In recent weeks, the gospels have been recalling a few Jesus' famous parables. These parables have been focusing a lot on the role possessions can have on our spiritual wellbeing.

I have been thinking of that adage, "you can't hitch a U-Haul to the hearse". How much do our

possessions get in the way of the quality of our lives, we can dwell too much on what we do not have rather than what we have. We can be overly influenced by the consumerism of our culture that suggests real happiness can be achieved by something we could buy.

This need to be surrounded by "stuff" can overwhelm us. There can be red lights blinking when the junk drawer in the kitchen is so full, we cannot open or close it. Our garages and attics can be stuffed to the rafters. Our walk-in closet is at a standstill. We do not need a storage closet; we need a storage warehouse!

I recently came across a book, "The Gentle Art of Swedish Death Cleaning." It is all about beginning a new way of approaching decluttering. The Swedish ascetic might be summed up in the phrase: "Less is More." The author suggests that there is a real spiritual dimension to beginning a process of liberating myself from stuff. There are many things that are easy to give away; do I need 40 shirts or ten pairs of shoes? There are things we hold onto with the idea that someday I may need this - we never will. Then there is the tough category of things to which I have an emotional attachment. I am a sentimental person. I could tell you where and who gave me every Christmas ornament. When I go onto my hopeful eternal reward, these things will have little meaning to whoever has to deal with my "stuff."

The author suggests that in the process of letting go of things, we are not letting go of the memories they evoke. I need to share with my family certain things that I want to hand on to the next generation, like a teacup my grandmother brought with her when she emigrated from Ireland to the US in the 1940's. Someone just looking at it might assume I bought it at an estate sale.

A primary motive for this process is in the title of the book, "Swedish Death Cleaning." What are things I can get rid of, give to someone who could use them or make sure my loved ones are aware of their meaning, so I do not overburden my loved ones trying to figure out what to do with all this stuff.

There is a spiritual dimension to what is stuff I am holding onto that is taking up free rent space in my heart and mind. How much clutter is related to resentments, poor choices, painful memories? Jesus wants us to embrace our real treasures and detach ourselves from that which angers, embitters, or hurts us. Where is our real treasure?

One of the great treasures here at OLPH is our ministry, Knit for Life. Thirty years ago, **Lori Klatt** and **Hilda Salvador** gathered a group to knit scarves, gloves, hats, and blankets for the homeless, poor and those in hospice. Since 1995 this group has been meeting and knitting. We cannot imagine at this point the thousands of people who have benefitted from their labor of love. **Regina Kilroy** is one of the leaders and reminded me that the group meets on the First and Third Thursdays in Hickey Hall. They are always happy to welcome any knitters who would like to join them. Happy Anniversary and Thank you!

As we begin to anticipate the beginning of the school year, we are always in need of catechists for Religious Education. It is a very important ministry and really fulfilling. If you are interested, please call our Director of Religious Education, **Erin Bretts**.
