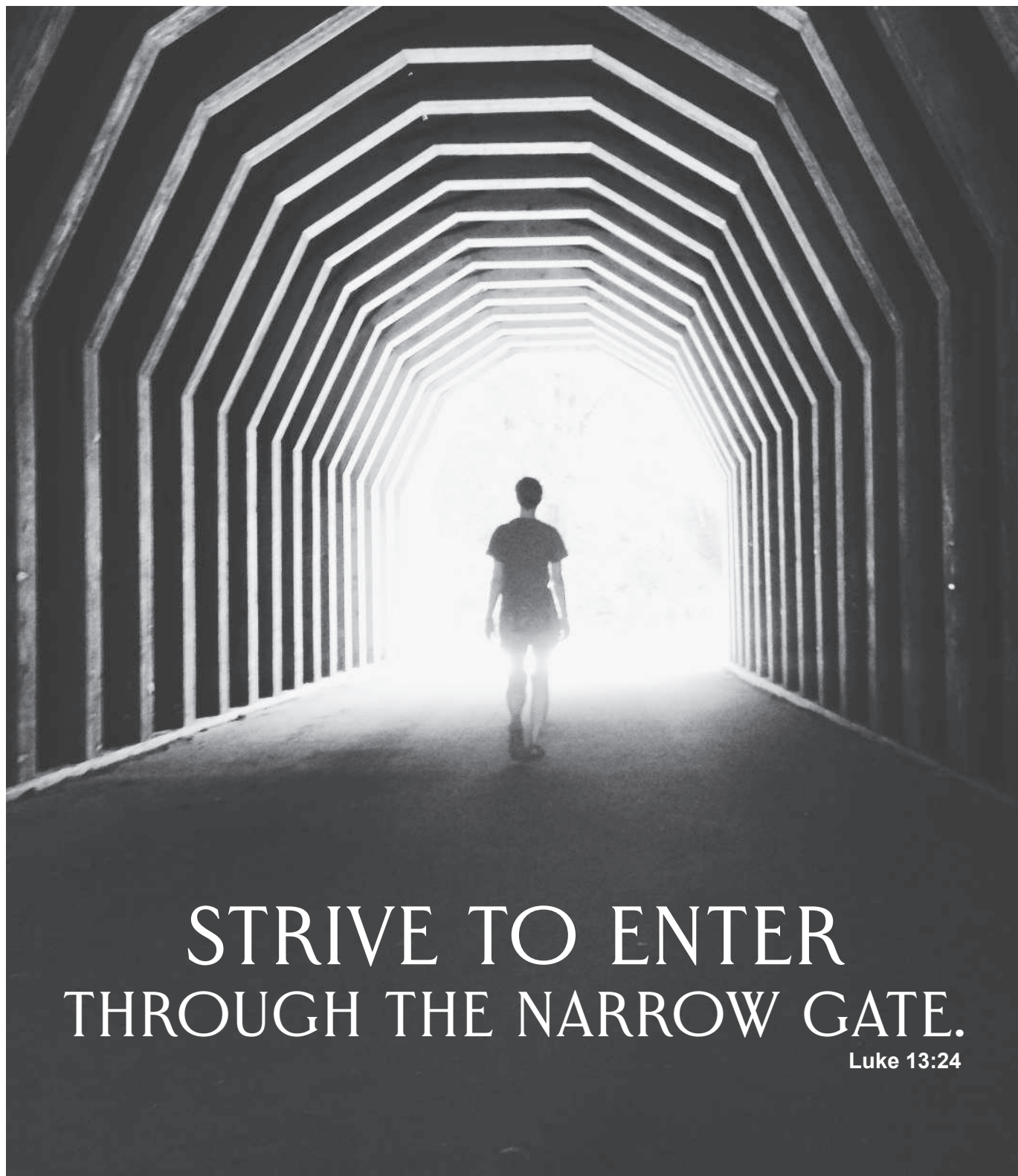

Dear Parishioners,

"Strive to enter through the narrow gate."

Well, it was quite a week for new beginnings! Most elementary school children embarked on a new school year this week, our parish opened as the largest Catholic school in the archdiocese. Great to see and "hear" our young students as they begin their studies with great enthusiasm. High School

students and many College Students also have begun the new school year.

I pray that this will be an awesome year for all of them. We can take for granted the gift of a good education. Elementary and high school years play a profound role in shaping the person we become. Developing a curiosity for learning is a lifelong skill that keeps engaging us to keep growing intellectually.

Availing children of the resources of our parish school, our religious education program and youth ministry will reap many blessings.

We are all striving to "enter through the narrow gate." The journey of faith is never easy and always presents its challenges but as we move through the blessings and challenges of life, a strong, vital, and alive faith is essential to our happiness and well-being.

My name is **Laura Koszeghy**, and I am a Scout in Troop 57 working toward my Eagle Scout rank.

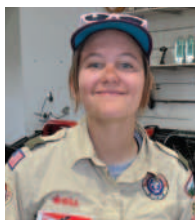

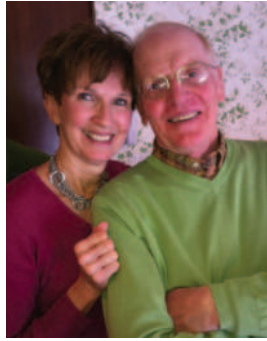

For many years Pat and Lou have given of their time, talent and treasure to support the students and families of St. Sabina Academy, and St. Sabina parish.

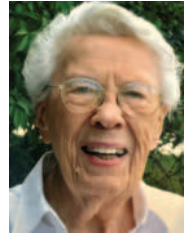
They have worked diligently to make the annual benefit a success. Their service has always been offered with a spirit of love and care for others.
