Dear Parishioners,

"The one who humbles himself or herself will be exalted."

The recent funeral of Ryne Sandburg, the Hall of Fame second baseman for the Cubs was a deeply moving tribute to a person who embodied the word humble.

Professional athletes live in the world of comparisons, competition, and the accrual of statistics. Ryne was remembered

as a player whose love of the game and commitment to his teammates was paramount. His life was much bigger than just baseball and he was surrounded by a circle of wonderful family and friends. His humble nature endeared him to many and stood as a great example of the power of humility. He converted to Catholicism and took his religious formation seriously. As I reflected on his funeral I was struck by the words of the Gospel this weekend, "the one who humbles himself will be exalted."

The scriptures this weekend are filled with challenges to us of the blessing true humility can have on the quality of our lives. A lot of energy can be used up trying constantly to impress others with our wealth, our power, or our need to always be right.

One of the qualities we try to instill in our children in the school and religious education is empathy. Helping them to better understand the feelings of another person. We invite them to consider "we" versus "me."

People who are truly empathetic are also driven by a beautiful sense of humility.

So much of what Jesus' speaks to is as true today as it was back then. We can become obsessed with places of honor, titles, possessions, and financial power. Jeus encourages us to walk with one another, to include in our world view; the less fortunate, the powerless.

This week I am attending a seminar up at Mundelein Seminary for the Tolton Parish Teaching Program. We have been blessed with several seminarians who have spent a significant amount of time experiencing our parish and contributing to various ministries. 

#### INSTRUMENTALISTS AND SINGERS OF ALL AGES NEEDED



Anytime is a great time to join one of the choirs and help continue to build the Music Ministry at Our Lady of Perpetual Help Church. This is a wonderful opportunity to serve God and the Parish through sharing your gifts of music and song. And it promises to be a lot of fun as well!

The following groups are all directed by our music director, **Russell Stern**. New members are always welcome and encouraged to join throughout the year.

#### **The Adult Festival Choir**

- We sing at the 9:00am Mass on Sunday (and sometimes other Masses) until the first week of June. We also sing for Holidays and special occasions. All singers are welcome.
- Rehearses in the church on Tuesday evenings from 7:30-9:00pm in the Church. The first rehearsal is on Sept. 9.

#### The 10:30 Mass Ensemble

- Sings at the 10:30am Mass throughout the year.
- All singers are welcome and instrumentalists are encouraged to audition.
- The singers rehearse in the church on Tuesdays from 7:30-9:00pm. The first rehearsal is on Sept. 9.
- Instrumentalists rehearse prior to the Mass or as needed.

#### The Teen/Young Adult Ensemble

- Sings approximately once a month either at the Sunday 5:00pm Mass and for Christmas, Easter and other special occasions, until early June.
- Students grade 7 through young adult are welcome.
- No audition required for singers. Instrumentalists are encouraged to audition.
- Rehearsals are in the church before the Mass at which they are singing, and sometimes on Tuesdays, 6:45pm (depending on the teen's availability).

#### The Children's Choir

- Sings once a month, either at the 9:00am or the 10:30am Mass from October through Mothers Day. They also sing at the Christmas Eve 3:00pm Mass, and on Easter.
- 1st thru 7th grade children are welcome.
- Rehearsals are in the church on Tuesdays, starting September 16, from 5:45-6:30pm


#### **Cantors**

 Cantors are auditioned from the choir and are then trained. They are scheduled to sing for 1-3 Masses a month depending upon the church's need and the cantor's availability. A Schola Cantorum made up of our cantors will sing periodically at the Saturday 5:00pm Mass.

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

Daily, we hear heartbreaking stories of suffering from Gaza. So many innocent victims, including those who belong to Christian communities, face violence, dire living conditions, and hunger. Our Holy Father Pope Leo has said "Gaza is starving," as he called for a cease fire. In a particular way, the faces of Gaza's hungry children make an indelible impression on our hearts.

Perhaps we feel helpless to address this complex story that involves international players. There is, however, a pathway for us to respond. Two very reliable agencies of the Catholic Church are already there providing vital emergency humanitarian relief and medical and psychological care for the sick, malnourished, and wounded. They are the Catholic Near East Welfare Association (CNEWA) and Catholic Relief Services (CRS).

On the weekend of September 6-7, the parishes of the Archdiocese of Chicago will take up a special collection that will be promptly forwarded to CNEWA and CRS.

Whatever you can give will go far to alleviate the suffering of our brothers and sisters in the Middle East. I know the compassion and generosity of the people of the Archdiocese of Chicago. In the name of all those who will benefit from your support, I thank you.

Finally, let us pray urgently for the gift of peace in our wounded world, a peace which only the Lord can give.
