Dear Parishioners,

"Pursue righteousness, devotion, faith, love, patience, and gentleness."

St. Paul's challenge to Timothy is a worthy one for us as well. As Timothy is identified as a leader of the community, Paul encourages him to be a person of virtue. He wants him to fight the good fight of faith.

Being a virtuous person is not easy in a world that is filled with temptation and a value system contrary to the Christian message. Greed, power, ego, pride, anger, hatred, meanness are all around us. We slip into very defensive postures towards those who are different or do not share our opinions.

It does not take much for the temperature to rise during what started out as a normal conversation. There is a lot of tension and stress these days and it does not take much for the negative or darker forces within us to surface.

The New York Times columnist **David Brooks** wrote a column on two different sets of virtues. He described them as resume virtues and eulogy virtues. How would you like to be remembered after your death? For your achievements, your status, your wealth? Or would it be your kindness, your courage, your integrity?

We are all on the "Road to Character." Eulogy virtues are born out of this inner struggle to be a better person, it is the way of being which brings light into the world as we exercise a desire to be grounded in honesty, kindness, courage, and compassion.

As we embrace the words of St. Paul, we need to be honest about where our virtuous living is evident and where we need to challenge ourselves. We do not always have to be right. People are entitled to their views. Everyone is on a journey, and we do not know their whole story or what is happening in their life.

A few years ago, we developed a program in the school

to encourage the kids to develop the virtue of empathy. I thought this would be a great course for all of us to participate in. I find myself speechless at the cruelty and disregard for people who are suffering that I hear around me, see on television, or read in the newspaper.

It all goes back to Jesus' foundational commandment, "love one another as I have loved you."

Lot is going on!

One of the blessings for me as a pastor in Glenview is our Clergy Association. Glenview is a remarkably diverse community, religiously. Last weekend I was honored to be invited to the celebration of Milad Un Nabi at the Ismaili Center & Jamatkhana here in Glenview. It is the annual Muslim celebration of the birth of Mohammed. I was grateful to be invited and so grateful for their hospitality.

Last weekend's SPRED Mass was just wonderful. I always cherish that quarterly celebration. If you know of any special needs children who would benefit from religious education, please call the office for more information. It is one of our great ministries.

This weekend we celebrate Blocktoberfest in Glenview! This has quickly become one of the most loved community events on Glenview Road, Thanks to the Village, the businesses, and leaders that help make it happen,
