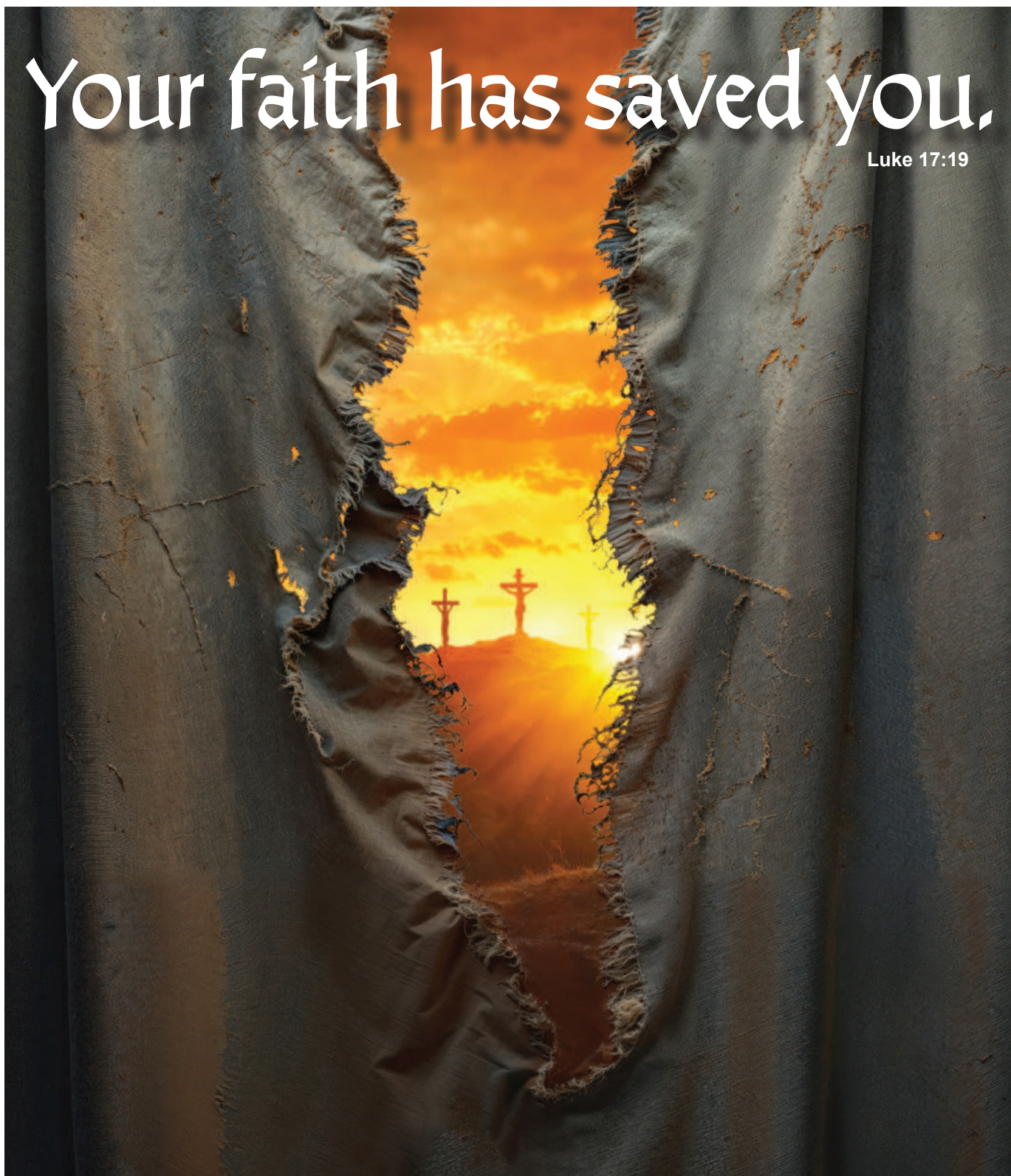

Dear Parishioners,

"Your faith has saved you!"

Jesus' words to the grateful Samaritan in this week's gospel are so reassuring. Our faith is a source of strength and hope. Our faith motivates us to emulate Christ in our dealings with one another.

It was the willingness to be Christ like, that was the most powerful tool the early Christians possessed in evangelizing the pagan cultures that surrounded them. People were deeply moved by seeing the way the poor were fed and housed, the opportunity to embrace mercy and forgiveness in a culture that was very unforgiving and cruel.

We are invited to cultivate a strong faith that can redeem us from the selfishness and cruelty of the world we live in. Our faith can rescue us from a shallow and superficial way of life.

I am so excited by an ever-growing phenomenon of young people of high school and college age who are being drawn to the spiritual power of being part of a faith tradition. They are running counterculture to the "nones" who have no religious affiliation. This young generation is seeing the emptiness of just living on the surface and not really being grounded.

Last week, **Fr. Roy Belocura** convened our first session of our OCIA, the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (formally the RCIA). We had the largest group in years, and many were under 25 years of age, several raised in nominally Catholic homes in which they only went to Church a few times a year. They are searching for a deeper more meaningful life and are drawn to the rich heritage of tradition and ethics that grounds our Catholic faith.

People have been wondering about the purple ribbons on the Church pillars. We are participating in the annual Domestic Violence Awareness and Prevention initiative.

Good luck to Fr. Roy who is representing the Rectory in the Chicago Marathon! I wanted to run but someone had to be around to say Mass!

We had a lovely Mass and reception in honor of **Sr. Joan Schumacher** who recently died. I really appreciated the efforts of **Beth O'Grady** and **Mary Fran Dolan** who organized the reception on the Rectory lawn. Several members of their guilds volunteered. Sr. Joan's family was so grateful.

Work on McDonnell Hall continues to progress. We are hopeful to be in McDonnell Hall in December. The 9:30am Mass under the tent will continue through October.

When completed, McDonnell Hall will be a great asset for many years to come. The renovation was a project of the previous capital campaign. Due to Covid, it was delayed and the original cost almost doubled because of inflation and supply chain issues. We want to do it right and are making the necessary investment.

I am grateful to all of you for your sacrifices and I wanted to express my special appreciation to gifts we received to enhance the renovation. We received a special bequest on behalf of the late **Bernard and Loretta Garvey** to replace the sound system. We received a special bequest from the late **Bob and Arlene Anthony** to upgrade the McDonnell Hall sanctuary for our weekly family Mass. We received a special gift from **Tim and the late Donna Thoelecki** to upgrade the kitchen. We received a special gift from **Mike O'Connor** to replace the copper pipes that serve the heating system in the Church. Can't wait for this project to get done!

The pastor transition process that will culminate with the naming of my successor in July is underway. I want to do everything possible to ensure a smooth transition and to take advantage of every opportunity to tell the story of what a blessed place OLPH is! On November 18, members of the Priest Placement board will be conducting consultations with the staff, the Parish Pastoral Council and the Parish Finance Council. More info to come!

In the Glenview area, North Shore Senior Center covers Maine, New Trier and Northfield townships.

In FY 2025 there were 425 APS cases reported to North Shore Senior Center.

Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion to the Sick

Oct. 25 & Nov. 1

Ministers of Care bring Holy Communion to parishioners who are homebound, living in nursing homes, or in the hospital. They share with them the word of God in scripture, pray with them for the Church and the world, and offer them companionship.



Through the Ministry of Care, we are able to keep long-time parishioners of OLPH connected and active in our faith community.

The work of the Ministry of Care is open to all members of our parish community, and a basic training course for new Ministers of Care will take place in Hickey Hall at OLPH.

The training will take place on two successive Saturday mornings this fall:

- October 25
- November 1

Both sessions will focus on various aspects of the Ministry of Care; however, the unifying thread woven through all is a commitment to helping you develop the skills and confidence needed to be a source of comfort to those who are sick, elderly or homebound.

These sessions will be facilitated by **Rick Nash** and **Jim Vlazny**, Coordinators of the Ministry of Care at OLPH. Completion of this course qualifies you to receive the Archdiocesan mandate to bring Communion to the sick, homebound and hospitalized of our parish.

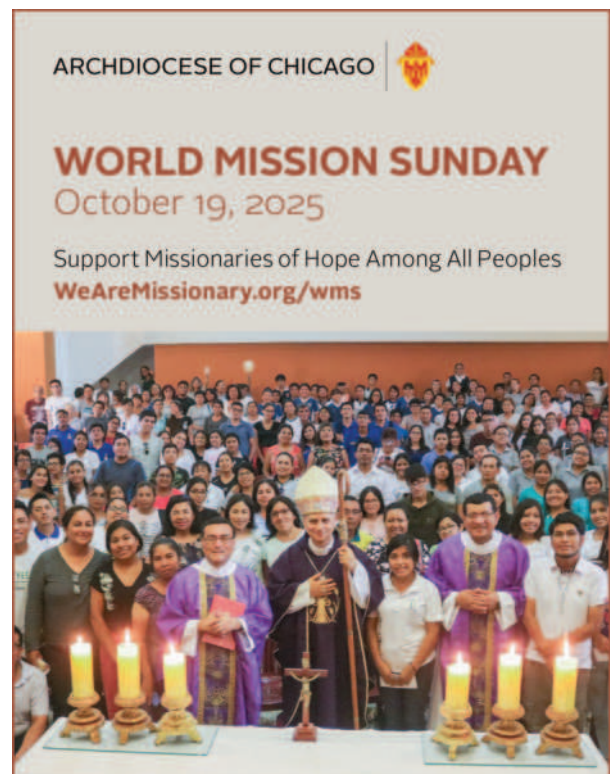
OLPH supports World Mission Sunday as part of our parish First Fruits Program, instead of taking up a second collection. As a reminder, the first 6% of each weekly and holyday offertory collection is set aside for our First Fruits Program. Instead of taking up certain second collections, OLPH splits this 6% of annual giving among our four sharing parishes and five named Archdiocesan second collections over the course of the year.

This Archdiocesan second collection on World Mission Sunday during the weekend of October 18-19, is one of the second collections funded through our First Fruits Program.

If you choose, however, to make a separate gift, there are envelopes available at the entrances to the Church; there is a button open on the GiveCentral OLPH portal; or, you can give directly to the Archdiocese at WeAreMissionary.org/wms.

Let us also remember to pray for the missionary movement of the Catholic Church throughout the world.

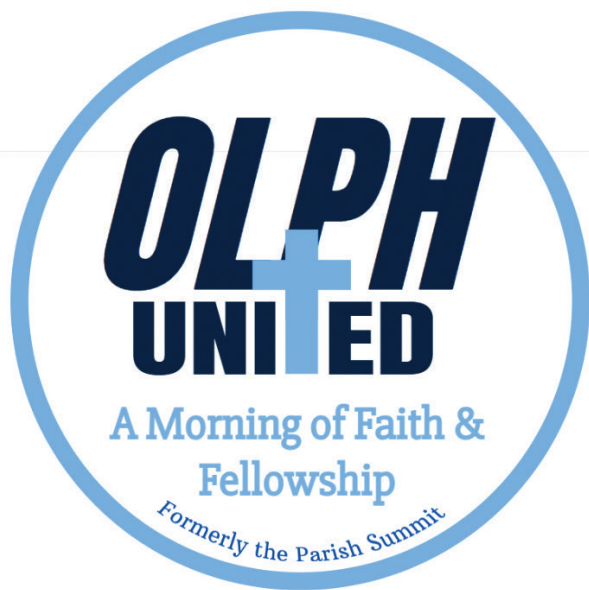

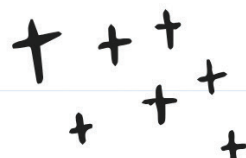
