Dear Parishioners,

"Be patient until the coming of the Lord."

I suspect that most confessors when asked what the most common sin confessed this time of year, it would be impatience. These can be stressful days. In addition to the normal challenges, things can be intensified with all that must be done for Christmas.

There is all the stress that can be associated with the expectations we have about

Christmas. There can be things going on that make the holidays overwhelming: grieving a loved one, family estrangements, financial burdens and the unrelenting ticking of the clock which brings us closer to Christmas itself.

Of course, it is much more than these challenges. Christmas is filled with joyful memories; highly anticipated family get togethers. The beautiful sights and sounds of this time of the year can bring peace and joy.

Keeping a sense of perspective is easier said than done. In our tradition we have a treasure of tools in the toolbox to help us not simply cope but allow the beauty of this time of year to elevate our spirits.

Advent can invite us to deliberately take time for prayer and silence. Tune the world out for a few moments. Simple exercises of meditation and quiet can make a big difference, breathing exercises can combat the stress eating away at us. Reading the scriptures can remind us that the story of Christmas is much bigger and more important than "to do" lists. Getting a brisk walk in, listening to music can help us to chill out.

Doing some activities that are generous in nature, donating food to the Sharing Room, or doing some volunteer work. Stopping by the Church for a visit can really help.

By tradition, this Third Sunday of Advent is called "Gaudete Sunday, The Sunday of Rejoicing. We have now passed the midpoint of Advent, the scripture passages from now until Christmas are filled with joy filled messages that reflect on the fulfillment of the ancient prophecies regarding the birth of the long-awaited Messiah.

What is a Blue Christmas Service?

Blue Christmas Services are often held near Dec. 21 (the longest night of the year) as solace for those who do not find Christmas a happy event. This may include those who are mourning the death of a loved one or a divorce; those who are suffering from illness, addiction, or estrangement; those who are lonely, struggling financially, or simply those with hard memories of Christmas's past. Whatever the reason, this service acknowledges that God still loves us and continues to be the light of the world even if we struggle to rejoice.

On December 17, 2025, the Catholic Community of Glenbrook (Our Lady of Perpetual Help, St. Catherine Labouré, St. Norbert & Our Lady of the Brook), will be offering a Blue Christmas Service again this year. **This year's event will be held at St. Norbert & Our Lady of the Brook Parish.** No registration is required and there is NO fee. All are welcome.

The service will be facilitated by certified spiritual director, **Paula Kowalkowski**, and will consist of reflective prayer and music. The service is a gentle reminder that we are never alone and that there is always hope.

Brief background of Paula Kowalkowski

Paula Kowalkowski has worked as a music educator on the high school and college level for over 30 years. She is currently the Music Director at St. Thomas Becket Church in Mount Prospect. Most recently, she received a Certificate in Spiritual Direction with an emphasis on Ignatian Spirituality from the Midwest Jesuit Province. She has facilitated programs and retreats at Bellarmine Jesuit Retreat House in Barrington Illinois.

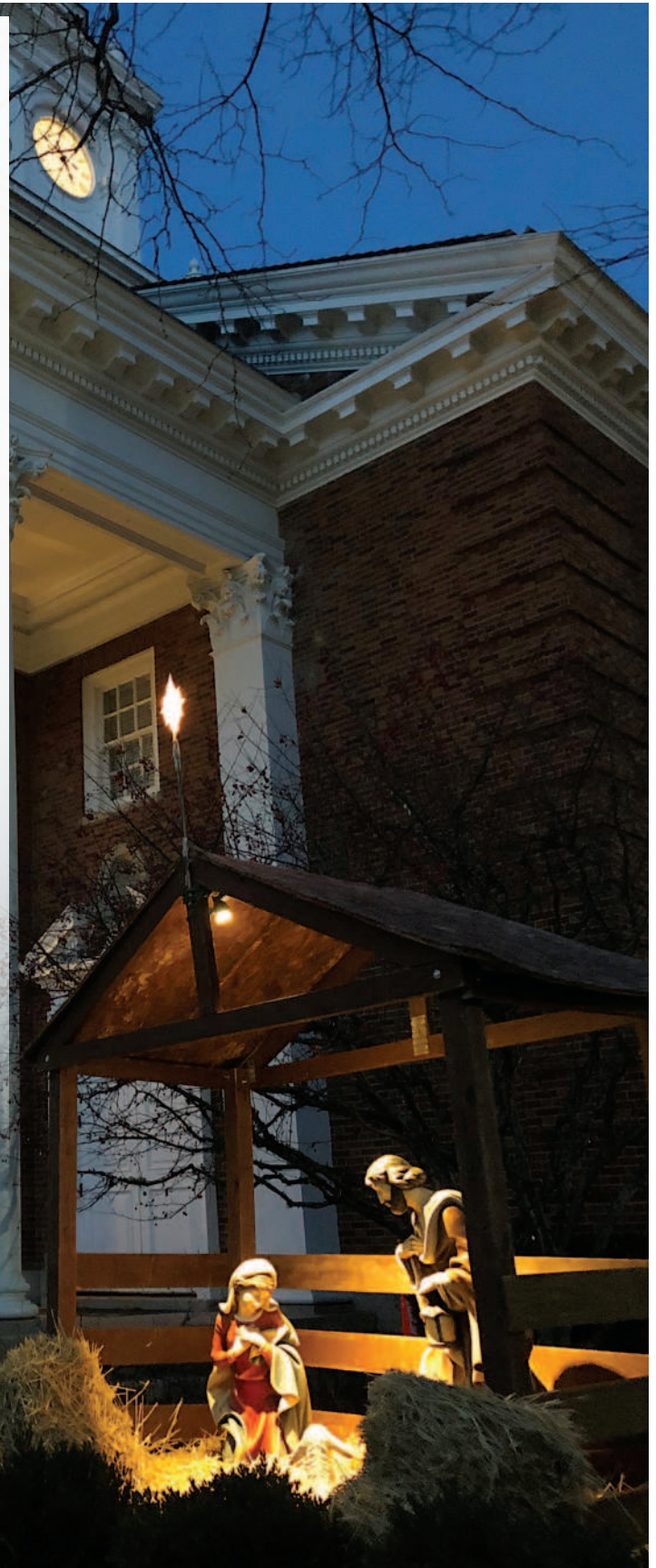

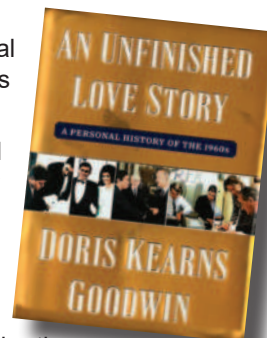

Retirement Fund for Religious

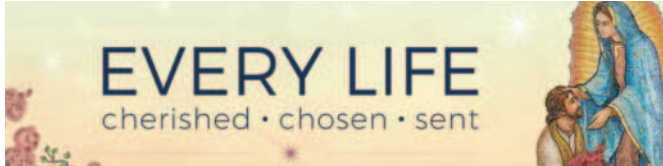

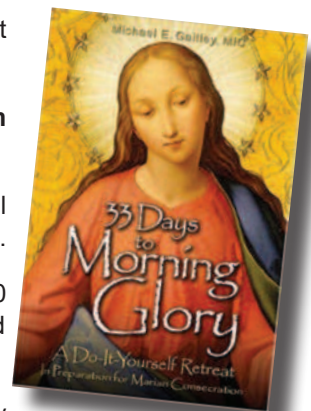

PARISH CONSULTATION AT OUR LADY OF PERPETUAL HELP

Upon the retirement of **Father Jerry Boland** in July of 2026, **Cardinal Cupich** will be appointing a new pastor to Our Lady of Perpetual Help Parish. The process of selecting that priest involves a great deal of prayer, research, discernment and discussion.

In order to gain wisdom from parish staff and parish leaders about the skills and talents needed in your next pastor, the PPB will be conducting a Parish Consultation at OLPH on November 18, 2025. Two members of the PPB will facilitate two meetings, one with the staff and the other with the Parish Council Members and Finance Committee. These discussions are very important to give the Priests Placement Board insight about OLPH and the capabilities needed in your next pastor.

The wisdom from the parishioners is also extremely important in the pastor selection process. To gather that wisdom, a form is now available to parishioners to answer questions which the staff and lay leadership will also address in their discussions.

Hearing Assistance
available in OLPH Church
and McDonnell Hall



OLPH has a hearing loop installed. Users with a t-coil in their hearing aids can listen to the sound system directly. Check with your hearing care professional to determine whether your hearing aid or cochlear implant has a t-coil.

Please note that while the hearing loop can be accessed in both the main church and McDonnell Hall, both spaces cannot access the hearing loop at the same time. For example, at the 9:30am Sunday Mass when services are held concurrently in the main church and McDonnell Hall, the hearing loop can only be accessed in the main church.

For best results in the church, please sit in the front half of the church. The hearing loop may not be effective in the back of the church, in the side pews, or in the Lady Chapel.

For those with a hearing device that does not have a t-coil, or if you simply would like to hear the service better, **FM based Assistive Listening Devices (ALD's)** are available to borrow. Please plan to arrive for Mass a few minutes early to find Sr. Paulanne or an usher to access an ALD.

Note: An FM based ALD uses radio waves to conduct sound that is broadcast through the microphone.

Instructions for an FM based ALD

1. Remove any hearing aid that you may be wearing
2. Turn on the ALD device
3. Place the ALD ear piece in your ear
4. Adjust volume as necessary

Return all borrowed equipment to Sr. Paulanne after Mass.

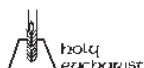
