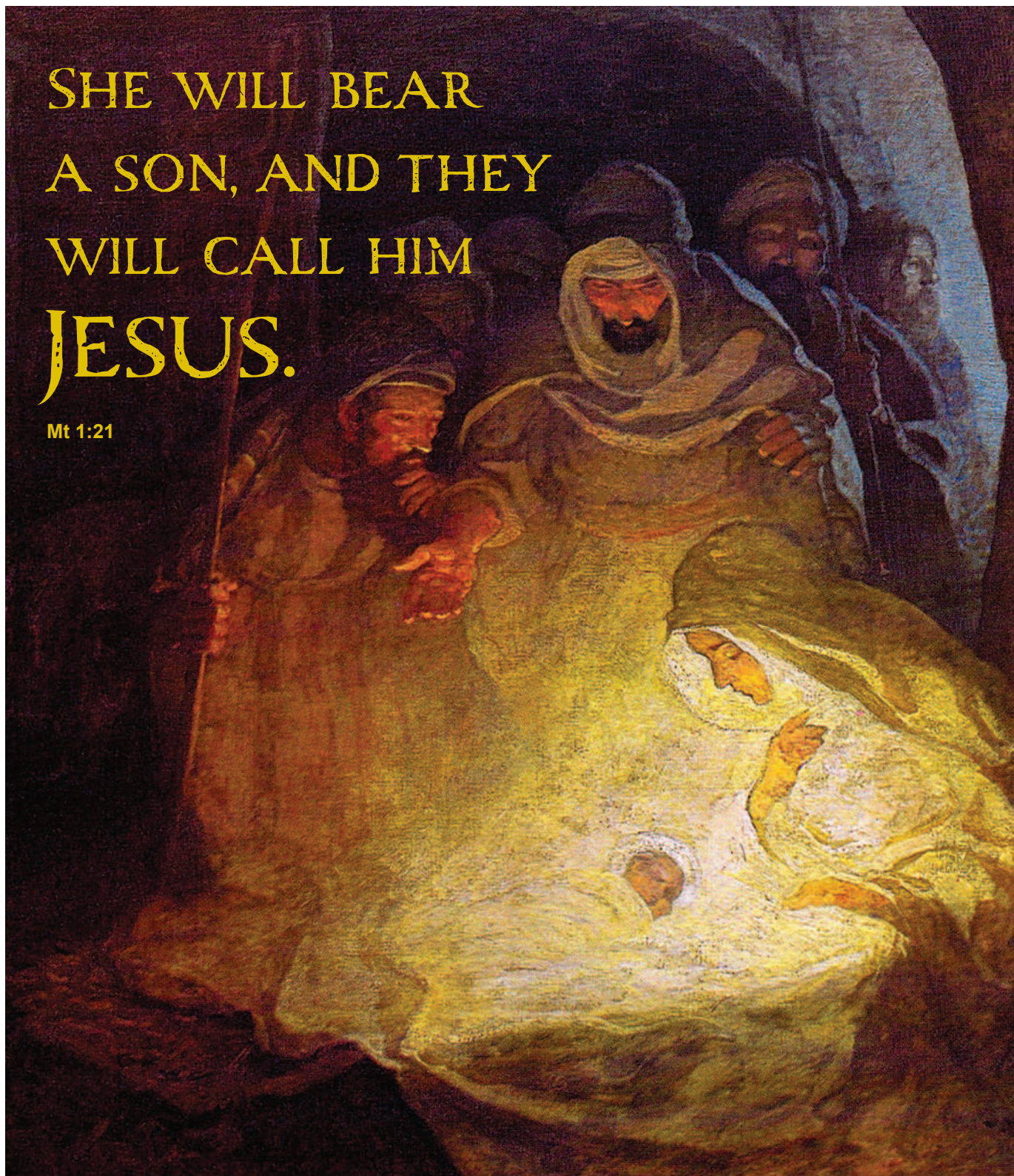

Dear Parishioners,

"She will bear a son, and they will call him Jesus."

Names are significant! We all have names and they define us. From the moment we are given a name, it will evoke all kinds of reactions. From the moment of our birth to long after we have returned to the Lord, we will be remembered for better or worse by our names.

My name is Jeremiah and I am the fourth generation on my mother's side where the oldest boy was given the name Jeremiah. I did not like my name in my younger life. No one had heard of that name, and I was self-conscious about it.

Things hit all time low when I was a sophomore in High School and the top song of the year was called, "[Joy to the World](#)" by Three Dog Night. It was not a beautiful rendition of the beloved Christmas Carol. It began with the words, "Jeremiah was a bullfrog." I have since come to like my name; biblical names are in! Jeremiah means, the "anointed one", so it fits in with my full-time job.

Jesus name in Hebrew was "Yeshua." His name means, "the one who is to be the savior of all." From his very birth he assumed the mantle of being, "Our Savior." When Mary and Joseph chose this name, they were inspired by the spirit. In Jewish custom, a baby was always given a family name often the name of the most recently deceased relative.

Yeshua was named for a child in which there were great expectations, a person who was seen as a future prophet or a person of great influence or destiny. Mary and Joseph were right!

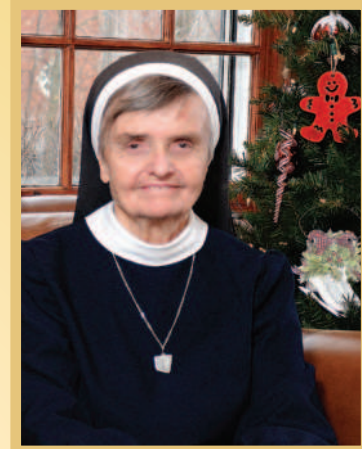

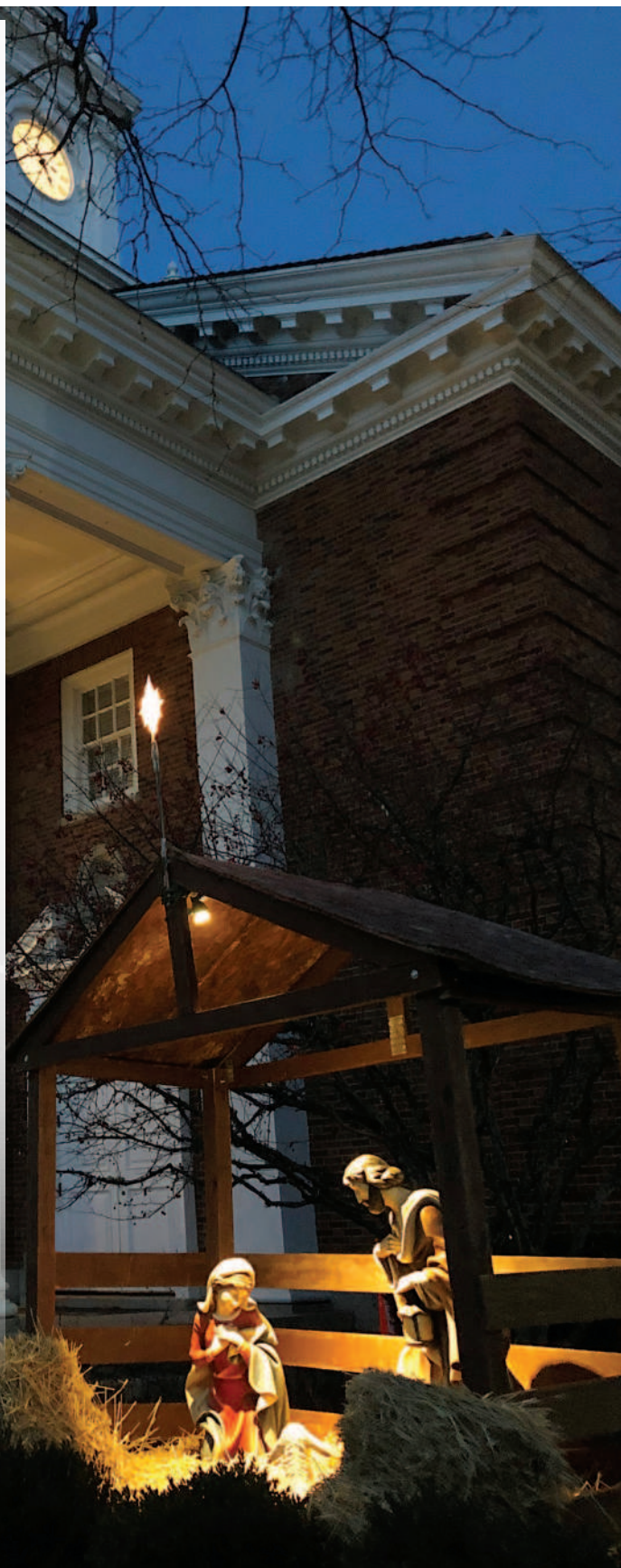

PARISH CONSULTATION AT OUR LADY OF PERPETUAL HELP

Upon the retirement of **Father Jerry Boland** in July of 2026, **Cardinal Cupich** will be appointing a new pastor to Our Lady of Perpetual Help Parish. The process of selecting that priest involves a great deal of prayer, research, discernment and discussion.

In order to gain wisdom from parish staff and parish leaders about the skills and talents needed in your next pastor, the PPB will be conducting a Parish Consultation at OLPH on November 18, 2025. Two members of the PPB will facilitate two meetings, one with the staff and the other with the Parish Council Members and Finance Committee. These discussions are very important to give the Priests Placement Board insight about OLPH and the capabilities needed in your next pastor.

The wisdom from the parishioners is also extremely important in the pastor selection process. To gather that wisdom, a form is now available to parishioners to answer questions which the staff and lay leadership will also address in their discussions.

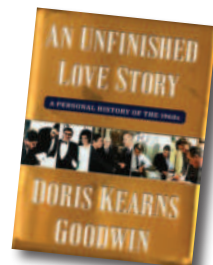
An Unfinished Love Story: A Personal History of the 1960s
