Dear Parishioners,

"Let the peace of Christ control your hearts."

One of the beautiful observances of the Christmas Season is this weekend's Feast of the Holy Family. During the holidays many of us spend a lot of time with our families and it is great that we can celebrate the significance that our families have on us.

As we recall the birth of Our Lord, we acknowledge he was born into a family with Mary and Joseph as his parents. I often wonder what his childhood and teenage years were like. There are so few references in the scriptures about that period of his life.

Certainly, as we read about his adult life his parents had quite an influence on him.

These are challenging times for families. The second reading from Paul's Letter to the Colossians should be compulsory reading. It is chock full of practical and inspiring suggestions on how we can heal and enhance the quality of our family relationships.

A lot of the pain and anguish families go through could be alleviated if we could embrace heartfelt compassion, if we would choose to be kind, humble, gentle and more patient. If we could let the peace of Christ control our hearts so much of the disagreements and hurtful things that cause pain and suffering would be lifted.

One phrase in this passage that strikes me this year is the invitation to "be thankful." Resentments can quickly build up in a family if we feel we are being taken for granted. Expressions of gratitude for kindnesses extended, sacrifices made or efforts to enhance our life makes everyone feel so much better.

My grandmother was one of those people who had a great way of being a grateful person. She extended kindness to everyone from the crossing guard to the wait person to the attendant in a shop. She had a way of making all of us feel valued,

During these Christmas days call to mind the people in your life for which you are grateful. It can really be an exercise of feeling the power of an "attitude of gratitude."

I have been focused on this in reaction to the outpouring of love and gratitude for the ministry of **Fr. Jim Barrett**. I have been overwhelmed by your outreach to me, knowing my many years of friendship with Jim. This parish has always been loved by the priests who have served here. The gratitude we priests have felt from you has only been deepened. I will never forget your support for me, the family of Fr. Barrett and the priests who have served here

We are on the brink of a New Year! There is always a fair amount of anticipation and excitement about what the New Year has in store. It is important to me that our parish accompany you in your spiritual journey. Through our liturgies, ministries, and programs there is great potential to make the coming new year abundant in its grace and blessings.

Two opportunities present themselves right off the bat. There are retreat weekends at Bellarmine Retreat House for men and for women. Several parishioners have already signed up. Bellarmine is a beautiful setting, and the retreat directors are extraordinary. See the Bulletin for more information.

This next semester of Scripture Study will focus on the passion of Our Lord. It will take place in Lent and will be a blessing to explore the biblical foundation of the Lenten journey.

He is a blessing to the Church and will be ordained to the priesthood next Spring. He will be coming back to celebrate with us in March. Congratulations Deacon Charlie Leidel!

Doesn't the Church look spectacular! I am so grateful to our Art and Environment Committee for the loving efforts to decorate our beautiful church for the Christmas Season.

On this Feast of the Holy Family, I pray that Our Lord will be abundant in his blessings for you and your families.

Fr. Jim Barrett loved leading the OLPH Book Club. The Book Club had been growing in popularity with each book.

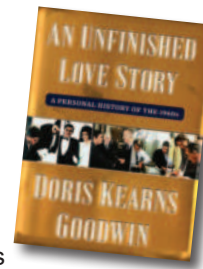

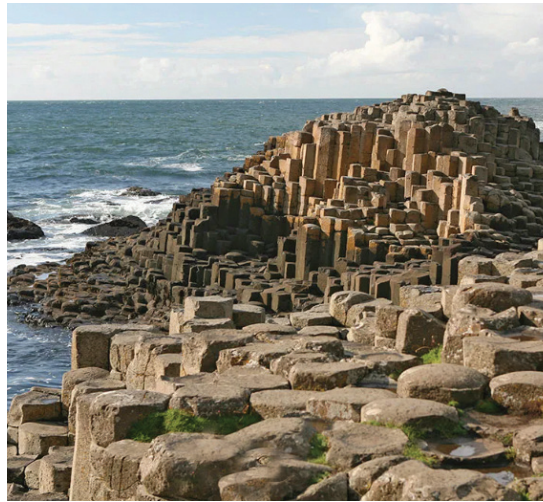

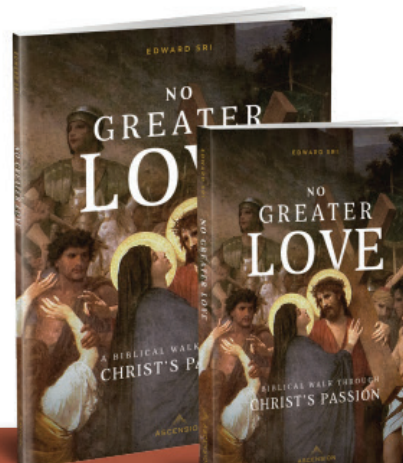

Hearing Assistance available in OLPH Church

and McDonnell Hall



OLPH has a hearing loop installed. Users with a t-coil in their hearing aids can listen to the sound system directly. Check with your hearing care professional to determine whether your hearing aid or cochlear implant has a t-coil.

Please note that while the hearing loop can be accessed in both the main church and McDonnell Hall, both spaces cannot access the hearing loop at the same time. For example, at the 9:30am Sunday Mass when services are held concurrently in the main church and McDonnell Hall, the hearing loop can only be accessed in the main church.

For best results in the church, please sit in the front half of the church. The hearing loop may not be effective in the the back of the church, in the side pews, or in the Lady Chapel.

For those with a hearing device that does not have a t-coil, or if you simply would like to hear the service better, **FM based Assistive Listening Devices (ALD's) are available to borrow.** Please plan to arrive for Mass a few minutes early to find Sr. Paulanne or an usher to access an ALD.

Note: An FM based ALD uses radio waves to conduct sound that is broadcast through the microphone.

Instructions for an FM based ALD

1. Remove any hearing aid that you may be wearing
2. Turn on the ALD device
3. Place the ALD ear piece in your ear
4. Adjust volume as necessary

Return all borrowed equipment to Sr. Paulanne after Mass.

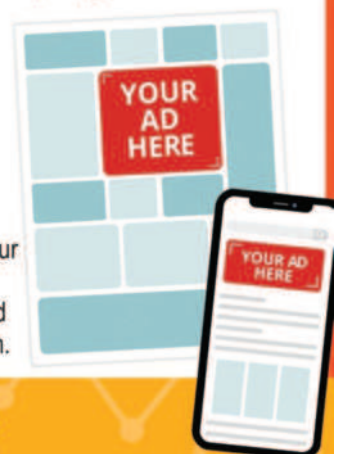

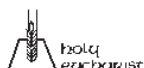
