



Dear Parishioners,

"This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him." When the disciples heard this, they fell prostrate and were very much afraid. But Jesus came and touched them, saying, "Rise, and do not be afraid." - Mt 17:6-7

Lent is the time for every one of us baptized Christians to intensify our response to God's

call of continuing conversion. We make use of one of the greatest blessings we received from God, that is the power to decide together with the responsibility of being able to decide. This is the season when we make our decision to know the Lord more clearly, love Him more dearly, and follow Him more closely, by making great use of the Lenten practices of prayer, fasting and almsgiving.

I wanted to share a few words about our Lenten Sacred Music concert which will take place on March 8 at 2:00pm in the church. It has been amazing rehearsing with the Schola Cantorum, which is a group made up mostly of our cantors. It has been inspiring to hear all of these beautiful voices together. The sound of this chamber choir (smaller choir) has a precious, delicate and prayerful sound that can open the listener's heart.

This concert will have a different approach, being a prayer concert. Though there will still be applause, so people can share their gratitude, I'm going to be announcing very little, so we can flow from song to song following the thread of many different types of beautiful sacred choral repertoire which includes works by John Rutter, Dan Forest, Craig Courtney, Morten Lauridsen, Ola Gjiello, Lotti, Palestrina, Gounod, Durufle and Lloyd-Webber.

Our wonderful soloists will include **Margaret Pasquesi**, **Ernesto Valenzuela**, **Luis Galvez**, and a special guest Mezzo-Soprano **Elizabeth Frey**.

Our concert will begin with some prayerful songs sung by our Children's Choir who will then combine to sing with our Schola Cantorum on a few compositions. I also programed this to be a shorter concert that will end within 90 minutes and will not have an intermission. I hope that you can join us for this special prayer concert and that you also remember to set your clocks one hour ahead of time that morning, so that you can see the entire concert!

Meatless Culinary Staples

Since the feast falls during Lent, meals are meat-free. Common dishes include Pasta con Sarde (pasta with sardines), fried fish (baccal?), and dishes incorporating breadcrumbs, which signify sawdust.

Special Pastries

Zeppole (or sfingi) are the hallmark dessert—fried Italian dough or choux pastry filled with cannoli cream or ricotta and topped with cherries and powdered sugar.

Rooted in Sicilian tradition, the feast of St. Joseph is as much about feeding the poor as it is about celebrating the saint, with tables often open to the community. These traditions are a way for families to honor St. Joseph for his role as a protector and to pray for his intercession.

Stewardship Report

To all Parishioners:

The results of collections for the seven months ended January 31, 2026 are listed below. As a parish community, you have contributed \$2,058,558 towards Sunday and Holy Day collections for these seven months. We are grateful for your generosity and the sacrifices you make to provide support to OLPH Parish.

Compared with the same period last year, actual collections for the seven months trail last year by 4.7%. We are also trailing the budget projection for this fiscal year by 3.9%. These figures include both Bridge the Gap gifts and Christmas gifts for both years, for which we are most appreciative. Expenses are on par and slightly under budget for the seven months.

The Archdiocesan Annual Catholic Appeal for 2026 has just begun, with a goal of \$221,256. Already we have \$84,000 in pledges towards that goal.

We have concluded the Appeal for 2025. Our goal of \$213,548 for 2025 was met, with a total raised of \$306,239, from 381 donors. Of that amount, OLPH parish receives approximately \$90,000. Thank you for your continued support of the larger Catholic Community of Chicago and OLPH!


As of February 26, 2026, Generation to Generation: Answer the Call Campaign shows \$1,616,295 collected and available funds to be used for OLPH capital projects as defined in the campaign case statement.

In conjunction with School administration, we are now completing the design stage for the Lexington building secure vestibule, as well as the Lexington elevator, and are awaiting preliminary renderings. The architects are also doing preliminary work, due diligence, and conceptual design relating to the Playdium/Carrollton project.

Early estimates of the cost of these projects, expected within the next few weeks, will allow the Steering Committee to prioritize the remaining projects in conjunction with estimated projections relating to the timing of pledge payments. We must have funds in hand in order to begin any project. Thank you for your payments thus far.

As always, we thank you for your continued sacrifice and efforts to help sustain the works of our parish and we are ever grateful for your time, talent and treasure shared here at OLPH and beyond!





"Mere Christianity" is one of the most popular introductions to Christian faith ever written. The book brings together C.S. Lewis's legendary broadcast talks of the WWII years in which he set out simply to explain and defend the belief that has been common to nearly all Christians at all times.

It is a collection of scintillating brilliance that remains strikingly fresh for the modern reader, and at the same time confirms C.S. Lewis's reputation as one of the intellectual giants of the twentieth century and arguably one of the most influential writers of his day.

Fasting

The Church requires all those between 18 and 59 years of age to fast and abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Fasting allows a person to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may be taken, not to equal one full meal. All Catholics age 14 and older are to abstain from meat on the Fridays of Lent.
