Dear Parishioners,

"Hope does not disappoint."

Assisi, Italy

I feel like a foreign correspondent as I am writing this letter in the midst of my retreat in Assisi.

Assisi is always a special place to visit. It has captured the imagination of people from all of the world for 800 years. From this rather remote mountain top

village a transformative spiritual movement was born out of the utter conviction and passion of St. Francis.

As is often the case, he was the most unlikely vehicle of God's grace. He was going about his life when the Lord invited him to "repair my church".

His response was a process of discernment as he first thought the Lord was inviting him to renovate the physical building of his parish church. He would come to see that the Lord was calling him to be a force of extraordinary renewal of the Church, harkening it to a process of detachment, rebirth, and integrity.

I am so blessed to be here! Pope Leo has proclaimed this a Year of Jubilee as we commemorate the 800th anniversary of St Francis' death.

One of the highlights is a one-month period in which the faithful are invited to venerate his remains for the first time ever. The Pope wanted this veneration to take place in Lent.

As I look out the window of my room I see hundreds and hundreds of pilgrims from all over the world each hour of

the day waiting patiently to experience this remarkable opportunity.

Lent began with the acclamation, "You are dust and unto dust you shall return". We face our mortality but as believers we know our soul transcends time and place. While St. Francis has long left his physical body, his spirit still animates the church, and the Franciscan spirituality continues to transform the mission of the church.

Hope does not disappoint! Despite the forces of darkness and evil, the mission of Jesus Christ implores us to love one another. Right around the corner from where I am staying are the mortal remains of another person empowered by that vision, one of the newest saints, **Carlo Acutis**.

This place exudes peace and tranquility. Boy, do we need this energy as our world is submerged with the reality of war and suffering.

I am praying for all of you!

On the cover - *Il Ritorno di Francesco* ("The Return of Francis") Statue

In 2005, Italian artist **Norberto Proietti** crafted a modern equestrian statue of Saint Francis, now standing outside the St. Francis Basilica in Assisi, Italy. Inscribed on the bronze plaque is a quote from the "Legend of the Three Companions", describing a crucial moment in the saint's life:

– Lord, what do you want me to do?

– Go back to your city and you will be told what you must do.

Throughout his life, Francis experienced many dreams. One such vision led him to aspire to become a knight and join the papal army. Following this vision, he acquired armor and a horse, setting off for Rome. However, during a stop in Spoleto, he had another dream in which God questioned his actions, urging him to serve God rather than the army.

We may imagine that the young Francis, filled with idealistic aspirations, feared returning to Assisi, where he might face his family's scorn for abandoning his knightly ambitions and avoiding the perils of battle. The statue portrays the future saint in a state of humility, prior to his monkhood – slouched in his saddle, head and shoulders drooping, his despondency mirrored by the demeanor of his horse. - photo and caption from gpsmycity.com



Meatless Culinary Staples

Since the feast falls during Lent, meals are meat-free. Common dishes include Pasta con Sarde (pasta with sardines), fried fish (baccal?), and dishes incorporating breadcrumbs, which signify sawdust.

Special Pastries

Zeppole (or sfingi) are the hallmark dessert—fried Italian dough or choux pastry filled with cannoli cream or ricotta and topped with cherries and powdered sugar.

Rooted in Sicilian tradition, the feast of St. Joseph is as much about feeding the poor as it is about celebrating the saint, with tables often open to the community. These traditions are a way for families to honor St. Joseph for his role as a protector and to pray for his intercession.

I wanted to share a few words about our Lenten Sacred Music concert which will take place on March 8 at 2:00pm in the church. It has been amazing rehearsing with the Schola Cantorum, which is a group made up mostly of our cantors.

It has been inspiring to hear all of these beautiful voices together. The sound of this chamber choir (smaller choir) has a precious, delicate and prayerful sound that can open the listener's heart.

This concert will have a different approach, being a prayer concert. Though there will still be applause, so people can share their gratitude, I'm going to be announcing very little, so we can flow from song to song following the thread of many different types of beautiful sacred choral repertoire which includes works by John Rutter, Dan Forest, Craig Courtney, Morten Lauridsen, Ola Gjiello, Lotti, Palestrina, Gounod, Durufle and Lloyd-Webber.

Our concert will begin with some prayerful songs sung by our Children's Choir who will then combine to sing with our Schola Cantorum on a few compositions. There will also be a special duet sung by the talented **Callum and Eliza Brueck**, two siblings who have sung with the Children's Choir for many years.

I also programmed this to be a shorter concert that will end within 90 minutes and will not have an intermission. I hope that you can join us for this special prayer concert and that you also remember to set your clocks one hour ahead of time that morning, so that you can see the entire concert!



- First Time Donors: **97**


Notes:

Power Red is a high-impact automated donation procedure that collects two units of red blood cells in one visit. The donor's plasma, platelets, and a saline solution are safely returned, making the experience more comfortable and efficient. This type of donation counts as two units even though it is only taking one unit of blood.


Information from the Red Cross:

- About 800 blood drives have been canceled because of weather and other issues since the beginning of the year, resulting in more than 20,000 uncollected blood donations.
- In recent weeks, distributions to hospitals exceeded the available supply of blood, drawing down the blood supply by about 35%.





It is a collection of scintillating brilliance that remains strikingly fresh for the modern reader, and at the same time confirms C.S. Lewis's reputation as one of the intellectual giants of the twentieth century and arguably one of the most influential writers of his day.
