Dear Parishioners,

"You were once in darkness."
(This weekend's second reading)

One of the blessings of living in the Northern Hemisphere is that the biblical and liturgical images of Lent connect with the world of nature as it is reflected in the changing of the seasons. We are going from the starkness of winter to the emerging promise of spring. While there is

a fair amount of controversy about daylight savings time, I must acknowledge what a difference an hour can make in daylight. I am affected by Seasonal Affective Disorder (SAD). Reduced sunlight affects my mood and energy.

Lent invites us to leave the world of darkness and embrace the emerging light that finds as its source, the Risen Christ.

It can be easy to reduce this spiritual journey to theoretical niceties and not be honest about the real sources of darkness in our lives and in the world we live in. This avoidance is the result of a lot of forces. We do not like admitting our sinfulness or blindness to what is happening.

Lenten conversion takes many forms. Part of it is listening, especially to voices that make us uncomfortable or challenge convictions we have that may have become disordered. We can all be impacted by the 24-hour news cycle or the perceptions of "social influencers". The prophetic nature of the Lenten journey is to make the uncomfortable, comfortable, and the comfortable, uncomfortable.

This Lent I have been really challenged by several reflections by **Cardinal Cupich**. He has invited me to name some of the darkness I have experienced in my own life regarding the application of Christian morality to the world we live in. Some so quickly want to dismiss his insights because they do not want to face the moral consequences of what on the surface seem to be political posturing.

In recent weeks, the Cardinal has spoken on behalf of the treatment of immigrants, racism under the guise of humor, the moral disaster of war as it devastates the innocent and powerless.

This has been a Lent of realizing that there is a lot of darkness that yearns for the emerging light of the Risen Christ. As we hear in the Gospel this weekend about the blind man, "He is the one (Jesus Christ) who opened my eyes."

Where is there darkness in my life? Where do I need to have my eyes open? What is the source of my anger towards people I disagree with? Why am I so afraid to

consider another way of seeing the world? How has my Lenten journey brought healing and compassion into my world view?

Next weekend we have a special opportunity to "see" some of these challenges. I am thrilled that **Sister Lucia Murashko**, a Basilian Sister from Ukraine is visiting us. She visited us a few years ago and many were moved by her powerful witness. She lives in Slovita, Ukraine, close to the Russian border. They are converting their monastery for homeless elderly and families with children.

Sr. Lucia was a recipient of Catholic Extension's Lumen Christi Award to acknowledge her vital humanitarian and spiritual support for those living in war torn Ukraine.

Sr. Lucia is a powerful witness of Christian valor and courage; she is a bearer of the light to those who see so much darkness. Thank you for your welcome to her and support for her mission. The second collection will be taken up in support of her community's efforts to ease the suffering of those who face such violence every day. If you want to write a check, please make it out to Catholic Extension and put Sr. Lucia on the memo line.

Special thanks to **Mike Haley** and the Men's Club who organized our annual "Blessings in a Backpack." Many of our OLPH 7th and 8th graders rolled up their sleeves and packed 750 backpack lunches for children in need in our community. Within hours of putting those lunches together, they were on their way to the kids that really needed them. I'm so proud of these kids.

Thank you for your tremendous support for the Women's Club annual Dignity Drive. We have been so blessed with the generous support of this effort. Hygiene products are so expensive and so challenging for financially disadvantaged people.

I am beyond words of gratitude for the wonderful St. Patrick's Day party last weekend. The Men's Club really outdid themselves. I was told that I had a good time! I was so deeply touched by the proclamation by the Republic of Ireland honoring me. My grandparents are doing handstands in heaven!

Congratulations to our Religious Education 8th Graders who were confirmed by **Bishop Perry** on Friday. They are an outstanding group of young people who give me great hope for the future!

Meatless Culinary Staples

Since the feast falls during Lent, meals are meat-free. Common dishes include Pasta con Sarde (pasta with sardines), fried fish (baccal?), and dishes incorporating breadcrumbs, which signify sawdust.

Special Pastries

Zeppole (or sfingi) are the hallmark dessert—fried Italian dough or choux pastry filled with cannoli cream or ricotta and topped with cherries and powdered sugar.

Rooted in Sicilian tradition, the feast of St. Joseph is as much about feeding the poor as it is about celebrating the saint, with tables often open to the community. These traditions are a way for families to honor St. Joseph for his role as a protector and to pray for his intercession.

Welcome back Sister Lucia!

Sr. Lucia will speak at all Masses
on the weekend of 3/21-3/22

For more than four years, Sr. Lucia Murashko has served courageously in the war-torn region of Zaporizhzhia, Ukraine. A member of the Order of St. Basil the Great, Sr. Lucia lives and ministers in a community located dangerously close to the front lines of the war. In this region, air raid sirens sound frequently and drone and missile attacks are an ongoing reality. Yet in the midst of fear and uncertainty, Sr. Lucia continues to bring Christ’s compassion and hope to those who need it most.

Every day, Sr. Lucia ministers to soldiers stationed on the front lines and to civilians whose lives have been devastated by violence. Many families have lost homes, loved ones, and the stability they once knew. Through her ministry, Sr. Lucia helps provide essential medical supplies, food, and clothing to people struggling simply to survive.

But her work goes beyond meeting immediate physical needs. Sr. Lucia and the Sisters help nurture hope for the future. They lead youth groups, organize courses that preserve sacred traditions such as iconography, and prepare both children and adults to receive the Sacraments. Twice each week, they gather young people, soldiers, and neighbors for prayer followed by a shared meal. Simple moments of community that remind people they are not alone.

Last month marked four years since the beginning of Russia’s full-scale invasion of Ukraine. During this time, the resilience of the Ukrainian people has been extraordinary, but the toll of war continues to grow. Many civilians and soldiers still face injury, displacement, grief, and deep emotional wounds.

Two years ago, Sr. Lucia visited Our Lady of Perpetual Help Parish through the support of Catholic Extension Society as part of our parish’s Lenten Almsgiving initiative. Her witness deeply moved the parish community. Now, after two additional years of ministry on the front lines, OL is honored to welcome her again as she shares the realities faced by the people she serves. **Sr. Lucia will speak at all of our Masses during the fourth weekend of Lent, 3/21-22 and to our schoolchildren on Monday, 3/23.**

Sr. Lucia has seen the physical, emotional, and spiritual impact of the war up close for more than four years. Yet, she remains a powerful messenger of God’s love. Through prayer, service, and accompaniment, she brings hope to the families, children, elderly, and soldiers she encounters each day.



"Mere Christianity" is one of the most popular introductions to Christian faith ever written. The book brings together C.S. Lewis's legendary broadcast talks of the WWII years in which he set out simply to explain and defend the belief that has been common to nearly all Christians at all times.

It is a collection of scintillating brilliance that remains strikingly fresh for the modern reader, and at the same time confirms C.S. Lewis's reputation as one of the intellectual giants of the twentieth century and arguably one of the most influential writers of his day.


