

In this region, air raid sirens sound frequently and drone and missile attacks are an ongoing reality. Yet in the midst of fear and uncertainty, Sr. Lucia continues to bring Christ's compassion and hope to those who need it most.

Two years ago, **Sr. Lucia visited Our Lady of Perpetual Help Parish through the support of Catholic Extension Society as part of our parish's Lenten Almsgiving initiative.** Her witness deeply moved the parish community. Now, after two



Holy Saturday Blessing of Easter Foods


11:30am, Holy Saturday, April 4



We invite you to join in Swieconka, the Slavic Easter celebration. In this service, foods traditionally eaten for breakfast on Easter Sunday are blessed.

Choose your favorite basket to fill with:

- Eggs** - a symbol of new life and the resurrected Christ
- Ham** - an acknowledgement of the New Law, putting aside the Old Law which forbade the eating of pork
- Lamb** - made of butter or cake dough, symbolizing Christ as the Sacrificial Lamb
- Horseradish** - a reminder of Christ's suffering and the bitter herbs offered Him on the cross
- Salt** - symbolizing wisdom needed in our daily lives
- Bread** - the essence of nourishment for our bodies and the appearance under which Christ is present






The Easter Triduum is the three-day celebration for which Lent prepares us. From Holy Thursday evening through Easter Sunday, our Lenten mood of repentance gives way to our eager anticipation of the Resurrection of the Lord, the culmination of the entire liturgical year.

By doing what Jesus commanded in the washing of feet and service to the poor, we recall the precept that still forms our vision of church. The Passover meal recounted in the gospel is an invitation to dedicate ourselves anew even as we welcome those who have been preparing for baptism and reception into full communion with the church.

We keep watch into Good Friday through services of Morning Prayer and Stations of the Cross during the day, and at night we ponder Christ’s passion and death in the liturgy of the Word and Veneration of the Cross. After the Blessed Sacrament is taken to the place of repose, a solemn vigil continues until Saturday night. With prayer and fasting we make room in our lives for the presence of the Lord.

The Triduum concludes with great festivity on Easter Sunday with Masses throughout the morning.



"Mere Christianity" is one of the most popular introductions to Christian faith ever written. The book brings together C.S. Lewis's legendary broadcast talks of the WWII years in which he set out simply to explain and defend the belief that has been common to nearly all Christians at all times.

It is a collection of scintillating brilliance that remains strikingly fresh for the modern reader, and at the same time confirms C.S. Lewis's reputation as one of the intellectual giants of the twentieth century and arguably one of the most influential writers of his day.
