Dear Parishioners,

"Blessed are those who have not seen and believed."

The gift of Easter is to be blessed with the eyes of faith. Last week, on Easter Sunday, we heard the account of when Peter and John entered the tomb and found it empty, "they saw and believed." The Risen Lord responds to Thomas this week, "Blessed are those who have not seen and believe."

The challenge of the journey of faith is to be shaped and influenced by the faith and testimony of others. Throughout the Easter Season we will be hearing the stories of those first believers, whose testimonies have influenced the experience of 2000 years of believers.

We are deeply affected by the testimony of others. I think of the impact the reflections of the panel on our recent parish Lenten Mission had. I recall the powerful witnesses of those who presented at the St. Joseph's Day of Recollection. Whether it is at Scripture Study or Alpha, a homily, or an evocative conversation, we are all influenced by the testimony of faith whether it comes to us by word or example.

Lent was the journey of personal renewal. The Easter Season is the time of communal renewal. As we recall the experiences of the earliest Christians, what can we learn from them? How rich is the picture of those early Christians as revealed in this week's readings.

In the passage from the Acts of the Apostles, we see how influenced they were by the teachings of the Apostles and the idyllic manner they lived in community. "They held all things in common."

In the Second Reading, we are reminded that although we have not seen him. We rejoice in the testimony of his Resurrection.

All week I have been in the afterglow of the glorious celebrations of Holy Week and Easter. It was the efforts of a legion of people from our Art and Environment

committee, the teens of Youth Ministry, our awesome music ministry, greeters, ushers, deacons, and priests that resulted in a glorious celebration of the liturgical high point of the year.

How wonderful it was to welcome into our faith community the many men and women received at the Vigil on Holy Saturday.

It was just wonderful to have **Cardinal Cupich** here on Easter Sunday. I am grateful for his presence and his affirming words.

I loved that we inaugurated the newly renovated McDonnell Hall on Easter with the family mass. It was so beautiful and made the long wait for its restoration worth it.

I am delighted to welcome our new Director of Religious Education, **Amy Ball**. She comes to us with a background in early childhood development. She is also a catechist and has children in our Religious Education Program, we are blessed to have her, and she brings so much to this significant ministry. She will hit the ground running with First Communion right around the corner!

This weekend we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday. **St. John Paul II** established this special celebration of the Second Sunday of Easter. This tradition can be traced to Poland a devotion developed by St. Faustina.

I just read **Therese Tirpak's** newly published book, "Get on Board the Mercy Train." Therese was one of our devoted parishioners and passed away in 2022. Her son **Tom** edited her writings that resulted in this marvelous book published by Marian Press. Well worth reading!

The 2026 Women's Club Service Award recipient will be **Joanne Nelson** who will be honored posthumously. I cannot think of anyone more deserving. She gave so much to this parish.

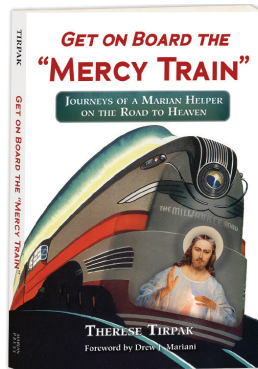

What is special about Divine Mercy Sunday?

In 1931, Maria Faustina Kowalska, a Polish nun, reported visions and visitations from Jesus and conversations with him. He asked her to paint the vision of his merciful divinity being poured from his Sacred Heart and specifically asked for a feast of Divine Mercy to be established on the first Sunday after Easter Sunday, so that mankind would take refuge in him

Jesus spoke these words to St. Faustina:



St. Faustina

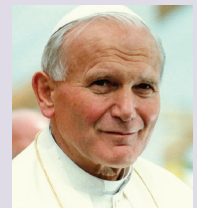
My daughter, tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners.

On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the Fount of My Mercy. The souls that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day all the divine floodgates through which graces flow are opened. (Diary, 699)

The image of the Divine Mercy is a depiction of Jesus Christ that is based on the Divine Mercy devotion initiated by Faustina Kowalska. The depiction contains the message "Jesus I trust in you" (Polish: Jezu ufam Tobie). According to Kowalska's diary, the image is based on her 1931 vision of Jesus.

In 1934, Kowalska directed the painting of the first image in Vilnius by the artist **Eugeniusz Kazimirowski**. Since then, numerous versions of the image have been painted by other artists, including a popular rendition by **Adolf Hyla** in Kraków.

On April 30, 2000, then-Pope John Paul II declared the second Sunday in the Easter season to be Divine Mercy Sunday. On the same day, he canonized Maria Faustina Kowalska as St. Faustina.

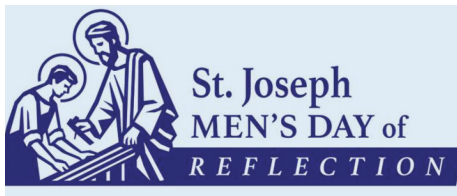

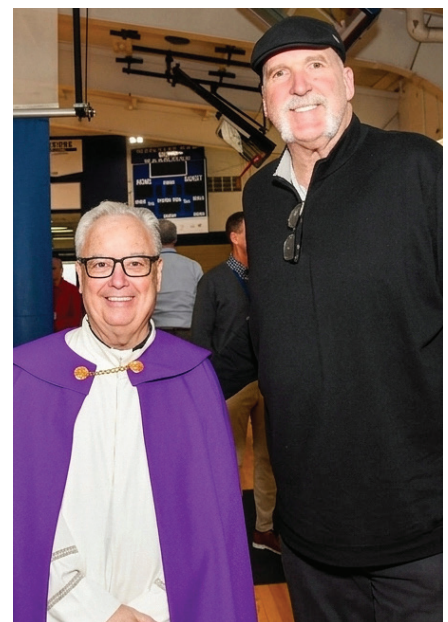

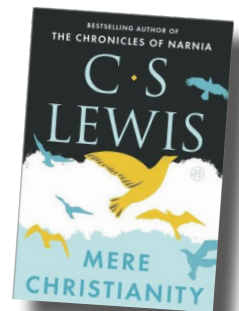
