Dear Parishioners,

"He took the bread and said the blessing."

During the Easter Season the Gospels recount the post resurrection appearances of the Risen Lord. For many people, this week's accounting of the Road to Emmaus is their favorite.

Some years go when I was on sabbatical, I was in Jerusalem for Holy Week and Easter Week.

There is an ancient tradition of processing on Easter Monday from the Basilica in the Holy Sepulcher in the Old City to the environs of Emmaus (as scripture describes it was seven miles from Jerusalem). The village of Emmaus has been lost to history, but scholars have a fairly good idea where it was. After Mass everyone was given a loaf a bread. I decided to Uber it back!

We all have "Aha" moments when something that was not clear becomes obvious. That feeling as a student when you finally figured out how to solve a math problem, when a doctor finally can figure out a solution to a medical issue, that moment when we realize how we have been hurting people.

For the two disciples, they had an "Aha" moment that was profound when they recognized the Lord in the breaking of the bread.

Easter reminds us that the Lord often reveals himself in the most unexpected ways, from the smile of a child to the unexpected new beginning of a friendship that had become distant or strained.

Easter is the glorious season of new life and new possibilities. We look at new ways of resolving difficulties or coming to terms with challenges.

Last Saturday's Dussman Council Clergy Appreciation Dinner was wonderful. I am grateful to my brother Knights for honoring me. Our Dussman Council does so much for the communities of OLPH and St. Catherine's.

Thank you to **Grand Knight Bill Cook** and all the knights for a lovely meal. I was the only one who did not win a bottle of wine!

I was sorry to hear about the recent death of **Fr. Bob Maier** the Pastor Emeritus of St. Catherine Laboure. He was a wonderful priest and pastor. He was so kind and present to so many. May he rest in peace.

Plans are moving ahead with the Generation-to-Generation Campaign projects. Final drawings for the elevators are being completed so initial construction can begin this summer. We are completing plans for the new security design for the entrance to the Lexington Building. With a state grant for security infrastructure, we will soon be installing more secure doors for the Parish Ministry Center and enhanced video surveillance around the Playdium and more exterior lighting on our campus.

The sanctuary furniture, new tables and chairs and cove lighting are all up and in place. McDonnell Hall looks great! Thank you for your generous support and patience.

The pastor transition process is moving full steam ahead! **Fr. Trout** made a guest appearance at the Knights dinner last week. We had him over to the rectory for dinner and he was able to meet the clergy staff, most importantly, **Sr. Paulanne**. He will be meeting with a combined meeting of the Parish Pastoral Council and Finance Council in a few weeks. He is going to be great!

I am grateful for your supportive words to me during this time. Many are wondering what I will be doing. Everything as of now is open-ended. Pastors do not retire from priesthood, but we retire from administration. I will still be very much involved in priestly ministry. Look at how blest we are by the presence of **Fr. Hickey** and **Mmgr. Velo**. And **Fr. Barrett** was also a great part of our parish life.

For the next six months the retired pastor does not have a public role in the parish so the new pastor can get established, I will be living in a van down by the river, only kidding! Towards the end of that time a discernment takes place with what is best. The Spirit will guide me as always!

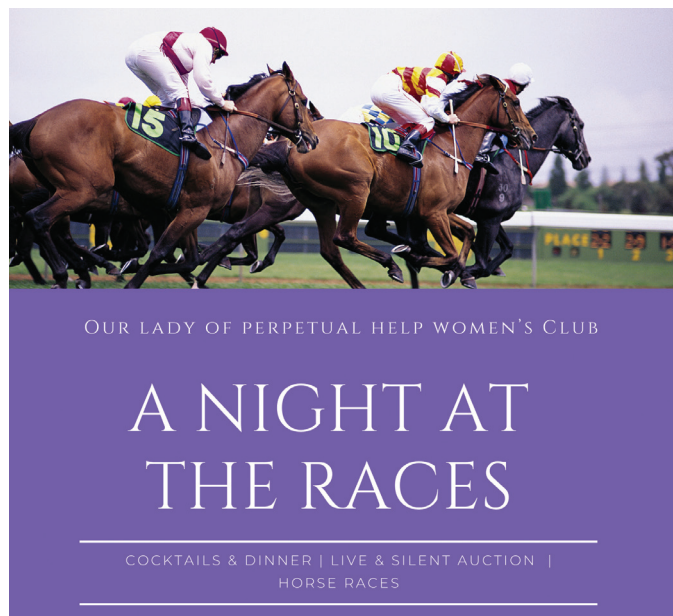
After Mass, the Cardinal graciously greeted OLPH parishioners in the Hellerman Garden.

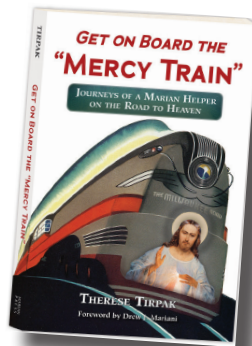

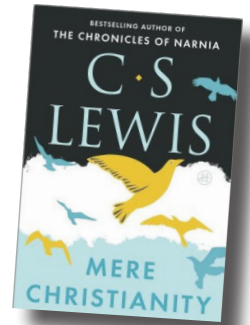

"MERE CHRISTIANITY":
A CHAT WITH C.S. LEWIS



C.S. Lewis was a man who loved a good cigar, a pint, and a chat at the pub with his friends, and that is exactly how he writes in Mere Christianity. His style is conversational, casual, and friendly, yet he writes with an authority that is captivating.

For example, check out this passage from page 52 where he talks about people that say "I'm ready to accept Jesus as a great moral teacher, but I don't accept His claim to be God":

That is the one thing we must not say. A man who was merely a man and said the sort of things Jesus said would not be a great moral teacher. He would either be a lunatic - on a level with the man who says he is a poached egg - or else he would be the Devil of Hell.

You must make your choice. Either this man was, and is, the Son of God: or else a madman or something worse.

Good stuff, clearly not just merely stated. Come join us for more (without cigars and beer) on May 12.
