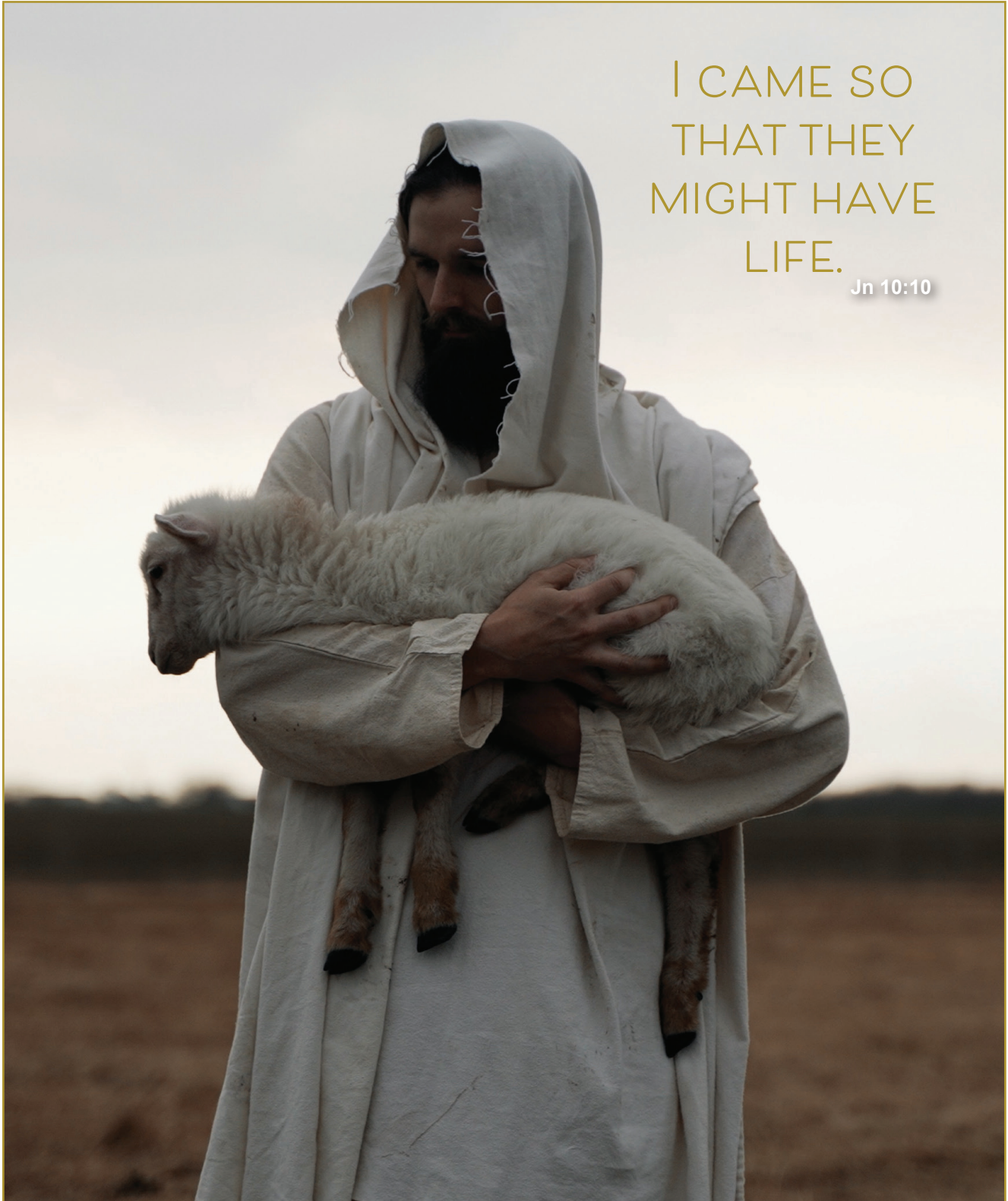

seek, share, rejoice - pastor's letter...

Dear Parishioners,

"I came so that they might have life."

Every year the Fourth Sunday of Easter is, "Good Shepherd Sunday." Each year on this weekend the gospel speaks to the theme of Jesus, the Good Shepherd.

Most of us do not have much life experience hanging around shepherds. Believe it or not I do!

I come from a family of shepherds. My cousins on my father's side raise organic free range Irish Lambs at their farm in County Kildare in Ireland. Many of the images in the gospel this weekend I can relate to because of my visits to the family farm. The lambs are very much like young children, they need to be fed with a bottle, they need to be woken up in the morning and put to bed at night. They do not know how to seek shelter when it is raining. They know the voice of my cousins, the shepherds, and over time they are all given names. The shepherds indeed know their flocks.

Some years ago, our late parishioner **Jim Wilson** gave me a shepherd's crook that was in his family's possession from the early 1900's. I treasure this link between us because he too came from a family of shepherds in Ireland. There is a picture of me holding that crook in the Bulletin announcing my upcoming retirement celebration.

This weekend as we recall the identity of Jesus as the Good Shepherd, we realize that he opens the gate for us, he calls us by name and seeks to come so that we may live. Jesus, the Good Shepherd protects us and leads us.

From the first moments of life, the Good Shepherd leads us to a life of meaning and purpose.

The Good Shepherd is an image that has a powerful meaning for pastors and bishops. We look to the wisdom of the Good Shepherd to form us as we lead our communities as a shepherd does. I hope I have been a "Good Shepherd" and have not lost too many of the flock I was entrusted with!

Someone gave me a replica of the pectoral cross of **Pope Francis**, which was emblazoned with an image of Jesus, the Good Shepherd.

One of the crucial responsibilities I have is to ensure we have a safe environment for children. This requires making sure everyone who has contact with children has fulfilled the necessary requirements involving background

checks and appropriate training. We also must follow several protocols to ensure children are safe. We have implemented several security protocols to make sure that children are safe. Between the school and Religious Education program we have over 1400 children here. We have any number of events and activities that involve children which demands vigilance and oversight.

With over 110 employees and hundreds of volunteers, coaches, and scout leaders this is quite an undertaking. We are all indebted to **Karen Daniels** who coordinates the annual audit of all the policies and files on everyone so that our parish is in compliance. With the assistance of **Lori Parsek** in the school and our Religious Education staff we always pass with flying colors. Thanks to them and to everyone who takes this responsibility seriously.

This week was the biannual performance of the Musicale in the school. It was fantastic and was a labor of love by the famous **Musker family, Pat, Colleen, and Mark**. This production was an amazing adaptation of Ferris Bueller's Day Off and featured yours truly. It was so much fun!

I can never thank **Ben Tchao** enough for the tremendous effort he undertakes as our parish photographer. He is so generous with his time and so patient. Ben captures many events and people that provide a photographic history of our parish, including those on the next page of this Bulletin from the most recent KOC Clergy Appreciation Dinner. Thanks Ben!

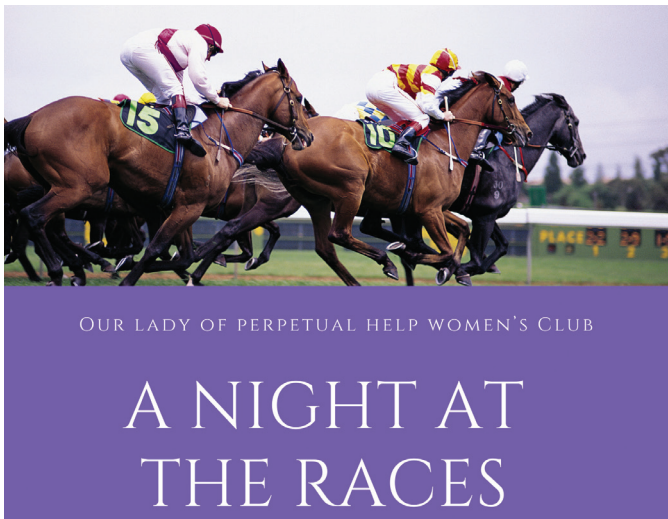

"MERE CHRISTIANITY": A CHAT WITH C.S. LEWIS

C.S. Lewis was a man who loved a good cigar, a pint, and a chat at the pub with his friends, and that is exactly how he writes in Mere Christianity. His style is conversational, casual, and friendly, yet he writes with an authority that is captivating.

For example, check out this passage from page 52 where he talks about people that say "I'm ready to accept Jesus as a great moral teacher, but I don't accept His claim to be God":

That is the one thing we must not say. A man who was merely a man and said the sort of things Jesus said would not be a great moral teacher. He would either be a lunatic - on a level with the man who says he is a poached egg - or else he would be the Devil of Hell.

You must make your choice. Either this man was, and is, the Son of God: or else a madman or something worse.

Good stuff, clearly not just merely stated. Come join us for more (without cigars and beer) on May 12.
