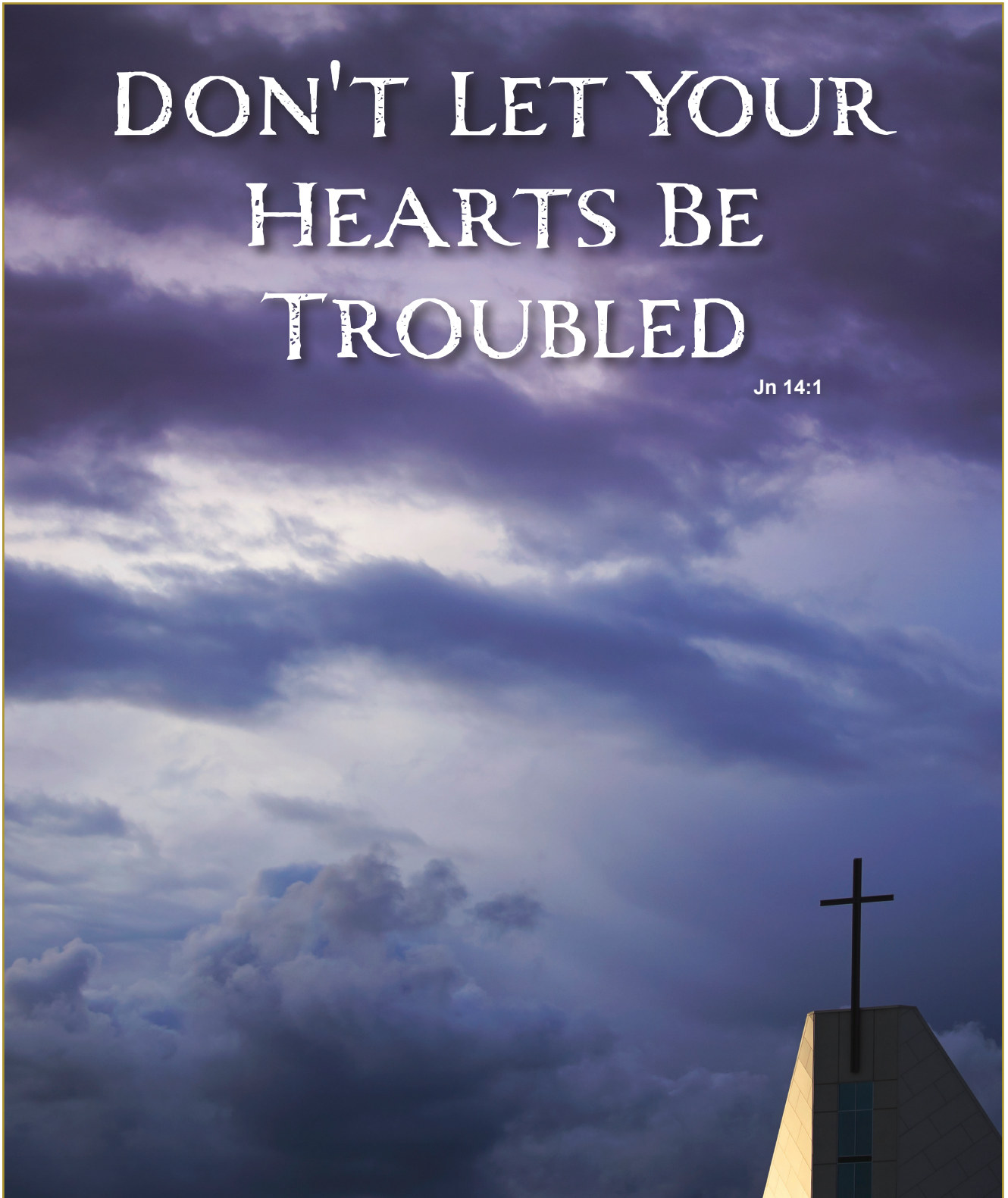

Dear Parishioners,

"Do not let your hearts be troubled."

The great theologian, **Bob Marley** who was also the father of Reggae Music wrote a song, "don't worry about tomorrow, every little thing is going to be alright,"

Wouldn't it be great to be free of worries, no nagging issues, no imponderable situations, no stress! Most of us have more

than enough things to worry about, from health issues to financial concerns to tensions within our families or workplaces.

Some worries can keep us from sleeping, other worries eat away at our sense of inner peace, others are just the simple challenges of daily living.

The late **Pope Francis** had a great devotion to Mary, the undoer of Knots. There is a wonderful Baroque painting of Mary undoing several knots on a long cord that the Pope loved reflecting on when he was a student in Germany.

He popularized devotion to her later in his life when he was the Archbishop of Buenos Aires. If you are like me, there are a lot of knots in my life that need to be undone!

The Gospel is very reassuring. The Lord will not abandon us, he will lead us to his dwelling place because, he "is the way the truth and the life." The way that leads us to Christ is never an easy one but the graces and the peace that only the Lord can deliver are abundant.

Surrendering to the Lord our worries, our fears, our insecurities is both a blessing and a challenge in the spiritual life. Easter is all about new beginnings, new possibilities. May the Risen One lead you, may we embrace his love for us.

A CHAT WITH C.S. LEWIS

C.S. Lewis was a man who loved a good cigar, a pint, and a chat at the pub with his friends, and that is exactly how he writes in Mere Christianity. His style is conversational, casual, and friendly, yet he writes with an authority that is captivating.



For example, check out this passage from page 52 where he talks about people that say "I'm ready to accept Jesus as a great moral teacher, but I don't accept His claim to be God":

That is the one thing we must not say. A man who was merely a man and said the sort of things Jesus said would not be a great moral teacher. He would either be a lunatic - on a level with the man who says he is a poached egg - or else he would be the Devil of Hell.

You must make your choice. Either this man was, and is, the Son of God: or else a madman or something worse.

Good stuff, clearly not just merely stated. Join us for more (without cigars and beer) on May 12.
