Last weekend we had two wonderful celebrations of First Communion with our schoolchildren and this weekend we will celebrate with all the First Communicants of our Religious Education family. **A total of 180 in our joint First Communion class.** We are so blest. Thank you to the parents, teachers and catechists who have worked so hard to prepare these children over the past two years.

Thank you to **Julie Eichenseer** and her committee for all their extraordinary work on this year's Spring Gala for the

Women's Club. It is a sell out and will be a great evening for everyone.

I am so grateful for everyone's generous support of the Annual Catholic Appeal. **We have surpassed our goal, all proceeds from future gifts will stay here at OLPH.** If you have not made your pledge, consider giving. In recent years, the resources from the Annual Catholic Appeal have helped us replace the carpeting in the Church, upgrade the kitchen in McDonnell Hall, and enhance the renovation of the Church Clock and Bell Tower. With this year's proceeds we hope to upgrade the food service capabilities of the hospitality center which is one of the projects of the capital campaign, Generation to Generation.

I have been deeply distressed by the financial malfeasance of a pastor who was serving in Evanston. Trust is so fragile and when it is violated there is so much collateral damage not only to the parish involved but to all of us who are priests who feel wounded by this. You as parishioners are also understandably concerned about how something like this has happened. How safe are we?

We had a helpful conversation about this at our recent meeting of the Parish Finance Council. Each year we work hard at following best practices of financial management and implementing archdiocesan procedures and policies. We are committed to doing whatever is necessary to protect the resources you so generously share with OLPH. This stewardship is the result of significant sacrifices you are making, and we must take every step to ensure these resources are invested in meeting the financial challenges of maintaining our mission and providing for the future.

There will be a subcommittee of the Finance Council who will review our internal controls and make any recommendations where we can strengthen our financial operations. I am grateful to **Bridget Baumstark**, who chairs the Finance Council, and **Mary Lynne Januszewski**, our Director of Finance and Operations, for all their efforts. Financial processes must always be reviewed and reassessed as the technology of fraud is all around us.

#### "MERE CHRISTIANITY": A CHAT WITH C.S. LEWIS



C.S. Lewis was a man who loved a good cigar, a pint, and a chat at the pub with his friends, and that is exactly how he writes in Mere Christianity. His style is conversational, casual, and friendly, yet he writes with an authority that is captivating.

For example, check out this passage from page 52 where he talks about people that say "I'm ready to accept Jesus as a great moral teacher, but I don't accept His claim to be God":

*That is the one thing we must not say. A man who was merely a man and said the sort of things Jesus said would not be a great moral teacher. He would either be a lunatic - on a level with the man who says he is a poached egg - or else he would be the Devil of Hell.*

*You must make your choice. Either this man was, and is, the Son of God: or else a madman or something worse.*

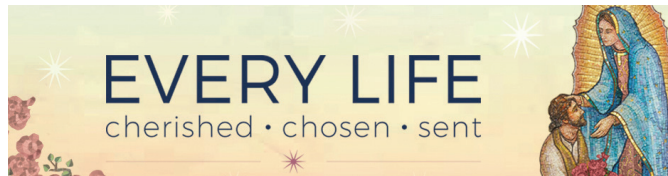
