Dear Parishioners,

"Lord, send out your Spirit, and renew the face of the earth."

This is the great antiphon of Pentecost! Fifty days ago, the disciples discovered the empty tomb. Throughout the Easter season we have revisited the remarkable journey that led the disciples from being in the Upper Room with the doors locked to their powerful witness to the world, "Receive the Holy Spirit."

Pentecost celebrates the birthday of the Church. It was from Jerusalem that they began to embrace their mission to "Go therefore and make disciples of the nations."

Today we celebrate the ministries that reflect this mission. Here at OLPH we have a blessed sense of this gospel mandate. Every day the sick are visited, children are formed, the grieving are comforted, the poor are fed. Ministry is far more than just doing wonderful things for others, it is the opportunity to live out our baptismal identity.

Thank you for your generous response to live out your faith in service to the Lord and to the larger world.

Pentecost is an opportunity to renew our commitment to be a Spirit driven Church. As a pastor I have a unique vantage point to see the cumulative power of the fruits of the many ministries here at OL. From the sacrament of baptism to First Communion to marriage to the anointing of the sick, the manifestation of the Spirit brings such new life.

This time of the year many of the ministries reflect on the efforts they have undertaken. What a rich harvest!:

- We had the largest group of candidates for the OCIA who were received on Holy Saturday.
- The Women's Club has its largest membership and the most guilds in its history.
- Our school and RE programs are thriving.
- We launched Alpha this year to great success.

In **Dave Ludden's** acceptance speech as this year's recipient of the Men's Club Hick's award, he made a compelling case for parish. It is in our spiritual relationships with one another that we experience the Spirit renewing the face of the earth. **Frank and Sue Ursini**, who received the Zanoni award spoke to the friendships and experiences of being a member of OL from Roundball to Casino Nights!

Last week's concert was terrific. **Russell Stern's** range of music from the sacred to the jazz tunes of the 40's is amazing. The music of my parents' generation was **Duke Ellington, Benny Goodman, The Andrew's Sisters, and Woody Guthrie**. We used to gather around the phonograph and listen to 78 rpm recordings. The concert was a trip down memory lane for me. "Don't miss the A train!" I now listen to "40's Junction" on the radio. Thank you to Russell, the choir, the outstanding musicians, and **Alyssa Allgood**.

I was deeply touched this week by the school's celebration of my retirement. Thank you **Dr. Mills** and our wonderful school community. I am beyond words!

On Pentecost morning at the 9:30am Mass we will have a rededication of McDonnell Hall. The Hall was closed for a year and went through extensive renovations due to your generous support of the capital campaign, "To Teach Who Christ Is." Much of the infrastructure work is not visible but we completely rebuilt the space. It will be a tremendous resource for the future gatherings from Mass to the Pinewood derby!

As we observe Memorial Day, we remember in our prayers in a special way all those who have served our nation, especially those who made the ultimate sacrifice to protect our freedom and the freedom of others. We can never say thank you enough. It is **Abraham Lincoln** who is credited with the national tradition of remembering the dead, especially those who had lost their lives in combat.

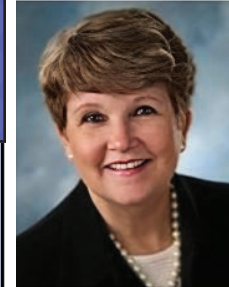
