## seek, share, rejoice - pastor's letter...



Fr. Jerry Boland, Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

*"May the God of peace be with you all."*

This weekend, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. It brings me back to my seminary days when we studied the doctrine of the Trinity in depth. The doctrine took shape in response to early Church heresies and the theological differences between the Eastern and Western Churches. One of our required courses, "Trinity,

Creation, and Grace," was especially demanding and quickly showed who was prepared for seminary life. It separated the "sheep from the goats." If you failed that course, your seminary journey ended.

I wish the Trinity were as simple as St. Patrick's image of the shamrock, which beautifully illustrates it. Over time, I have come to see Trinity as being about relationships. This weekend, we reflect on the relationship between the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

Their relationship is immersed in a circle of love. Out of this grounding in the power of love, the three persons of the Trinity thrive in its infinite power and unconditional commitment.

The Trinity celebrates the relationship of the Father, Son, and Spirit but also our relationship to God and one another. The mission of the Church is to build relationships within the community of faith in which we, "mend our ways and encourage one another" as St. Paul teaches us in the second reading from his Letter to the Corinthians. This reading, though brief, is laden with powerful challenges on how the Trinity can shape and form our relationships with one another. Embracing the God of peace changes the nature of our commitment to God and the world.

**Pope Leo** reflected recently on the state of the world, commenting that, "War is back in vogue and a zeal for war is spreading." As Christians we must resist these impulses and embrace a path of peaceful resolution as we mirror the love of the Trinity.

Special thanks to **Margie André** and the Alpha Team for the successful launching of the Alpha program this year. Watch the Bulletin for information for the next session in the Fall. It has led to great conversations on faith and living a spiritual life.

It is the season of Graduations! We have had a wonderful celebration of the Graduation Class of 2026 here at our parish school. This week is Kindergarten Graduation. I extend my best wishes to all our graduates who attend the

many schools and high schools that serve our community. Also, all my best to our college and graduate school graduates. We are so proud of your accomplishments. Our young people will make a tremendous difference in whatever path they follow in the future.

It has been a wonderful year for our Youth Ministry program under the direction of **Zoe Sundstrom**. So much has happened! Building bridges of connection to our teens is important. They have so much to offer our parish and we to them.

Our "Generation to Generation" Committee that is overseeing the capital campaign projects is moving ahead. Work this summer will involve the new more secure entrance to the Lexington Building. The first phase of the elevator for Lexington will also take place. Next up will be preliminary review of the plan for the Glenview Road entrance and **Sr. Paulanne's** Garage. Then we should have the money to complete the second elevator for the Playdium. Thank you for your generous support of the capital campaign.

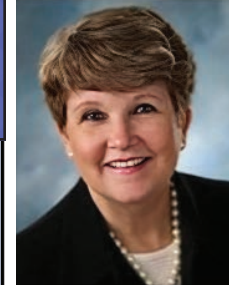
