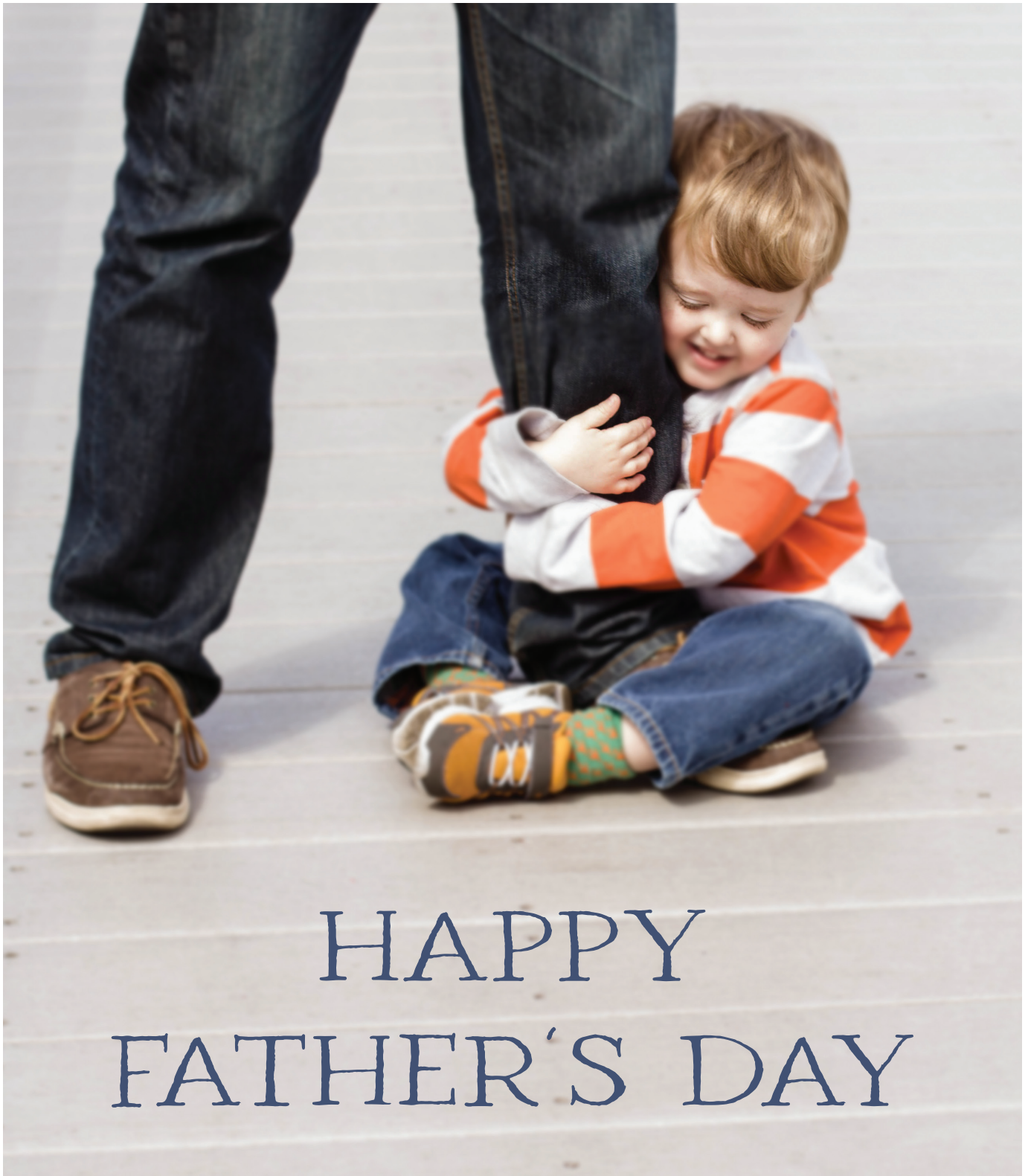

## seek, share, rejoice - pastor's letter...

Dear Parishioners,  
“Do not be afraid.”

These words from this week's Gospel were a cornerstone of the preaching of St. John Paul II. He spoke to a world that was in danger because of nuclear proliferation, communist governments, fascist governments, and overwhelming poverty.

The Pope used his global pulpit to communicate the reassuring love of Jesus Christ. His words of reassurance found a place in the hearts of those troubled and suffering.

One of the great challenges facing the Church in the modern world has to do with communication. How do we take advantage of modern technologies in bringing the Good News into the world? The Church traditionally has been behind these kinds of developments.

I have been amazed at how much has changed though. Last week there was an awful incident with a 6-foot cross that was set on fire in Grant Park. This invoked memories of the hatred espoused by the KKK. Within hours Cardinal Cupich issued a press release, communicated his condemnation of this racist act and an email was sent to all the priests and faithful of the archdiocese. There was a time not too long ago that by the time people would have received the Cardinal's comments it would have been days since the incident.

As pastor I have been blessed with a variety of forums to communicate. Our parish has invested in technology to livestream Masses, to issue Daily E-blasts, to maintain a presence on Facebook, Instagram, the website, the Bulletin to mention a few.

We are blest by our Director of Communications, **Terry Luc**, who does an amazing job of helping to communicate our mission and to keep you up to date on what is happening. From the Annual Report to Fireside Chats, he helps us stay connected.

I am also grateful to **Jim Geldermann**, **Rob Orr**, **John Nicolau**, and **Ben Tchaou** who are all important people in our public outreach through live streaming, technology, and images.

Staying connected has been an important priority for me as pastor. I have tried to keep you in touch with my take on things and use the platforms available to me to evangelize.

One of those platforms has been the weekly letter in the Bulletin. I feel many pastors do not appreciate how effective these reflections can be.

I was influenced by some of the great pastor letter writers

in my life. I think of **Bishop John Gorman** who was the pastor of St. Michael's in Orland Park. He earned a doctorate in Clinical Psychology and often shared articles on human development from a spiritual point of view.

I think of **Fr. Bill Flaherty** who had been the pastor of St. Nicholas in Evanston and who could have been a comedy writer for Saturday Night Live. His letters were so entertaining. I think of **Fr. Bill Kenneally** who was pastor of St. Getrude's, he also wrote about news you can use. He really created a sense of community.

**Fr. Leo Mahon** the pastor of St Victor's in Calumet City wrote powerful and inspiring reflections on the social mission of the Church. I incorporated elements of all these great pastors in my efforts.

I have been so privileged to have this forum. Thank you for your feedback and reactions, it always motivated me to make the best use of this opportunity.

Thank you for your tremendous support and encouragement. I will be forever grateful.

# Summer with St. Francis

From the book *The Life of St. Francis*  
written by St. Bonaventure, a Franciscan monk and mystic, in 1260.

## Week 2: Chapter 1 continued

*When we left off, Francis was begging God to show him what he should do with his life.*



*St. Francis and the leper*

One day while he was riding on horseback to the plain that lies below the town of Assisi, he came upon a leper. This unforeseen encounter struck him with horror. But he recalled his resolution to be perfect and remembered that he must first conquer himself if he wanted to become a knight of Christ.

He slipped off his horse and ran to kiss the man. When the leper put out his hand as if to receive some alms, Francis gave him money and a kiss. Immediately mounting his horse, Francis looked all around. But although the open plain stretched clear in all directions, he could not see the leper anywhere. Filled with wonder and joy, he began devoutly to sing God's praises, resolving from this always to strive to do greater things in the future.

After that, he began to seek out solitary places, well suited for sorrow. One day while he was praying in such a secluded spot and became totally absorbed in God through his extreme fervor, Jesus Christ appeared to him fastened to the Cross. Francis' soul melted at the sight, and the memory of Christ's Passion was so impressed on the innermost recesses of this heart that from that hour, whenever Christ's crucifixion came to his mind, he could scarcely contain his tears and sighs.

Through this the man of God understood as addressed to himself the Gospel text: "If you wish to come after me, deny yourself and take up your cross and follow me." (Matthew 16:24)

From that time on he clothed himself with the spirit of poverty, humility, and a feeling of intimate devotion. Formerly he used to be horrified not only by close dealings with lepers, but by their very sight, even from a distance; but now he rendered humble service to the lepers with human concern and devoted kindness in order that he might completely despise himself, because of Christ crucified, who, according to the text of the prophet was despised as a leper (Isaiah 53:3). He visited their houses frequently, generously distributed alms to them and with great compassion kissed their hands and their mouths.

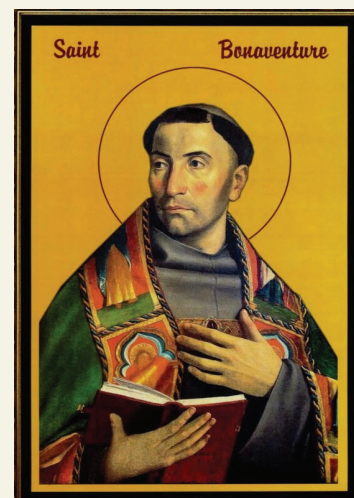
## Did St. Francis cure Bonaventure as a child?

Next to God, we owe a debt of gratitude to St. Francis for the great Doctor of the Church and minister general of the Franciscan order, St. Bonaventure. Bonaventure was born at Bagnorea in the Papal States in 1221, and was given the name John in baptism.

As a child of four years he became seriously ill and was given up by the physicians. Then his mother hastened to Friar Francis, who was preaching in the vicinity just then, and begged him to come and heal her child.

The future saint acceded to her request; he prayed over the child, and immediately he was cured. Francis is said then to have uttered the prophetic words: "O buonaventura!" which means "O blessed things to come!" For that reason, he received the name Bonaventure when he became a Franciscan at the age of 22 and forever was indebted to God for saving his life through Francis. –

To beggars he wished to give not only his possessions but his very self. At times he took off his clothes, at times unstitched them, at times ripped them in pieces, in order to give them to beggars, when he had nothing else at hand.

During this time, he made a pilgrimage to the shrine of St. Peter, where he saw a large number of the poor before the entrance of the church. Led partly by the sweetness of his devotion, partly by the love of poverty, he gave his own clothes to one of the neediest among them.

Then he dressed in the poor man's rags and spent that day in the midst of the poor with an unaccustomed joy of spirit. This he did in order to spurn worldly glory and, by ascending in stages, to arrive at the perfection of the Gospel.

He paid great attention to the mortification of the flesh, so that he might carry externally in his body the cross of Christ, which he carried internally in his heart. Francis, the man of God, did all these things when he was not yet withdrawn from the dress and the life of the world.

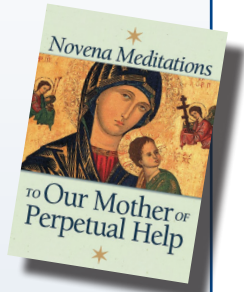
