The Sacrament Of Reconciliation

Confession, also known as Reconciliation or Penance, puts us face to face with the mercy and forgiveness of Christ. Each Saturday afternoon (except Holy Saturday), a priest is available in church to hear confessions.

Fasting

The Church requires all those between 18 and 59 years of age to fast and abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

Fasting allows a person to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may be taken, not to equal one full meal.

All Catholics age 14 and older are to abstain from meat on the Fridays of Lent.
